


CELTIC KNOT



The Celtic Knot is a traditional design that has been seen since around 450 AD. Celtic Knots are traditional Irish, Scottish and Welsh symbols. In this piece I have quilt to sizes of Celtic Knot.



CELTIC KNOT



Place the Locating Pin in Pin 1 and using the Westalee Design Circles on Quilts Template stitch from Reference Line A to Reference Line B shown in RED.

Move the Locating Pin to Pin 2 and stitch from Reference Line B to Reference Line C shown in BLUE. Move the Locating Pin to Pin 3 and stitch from Reference Line B to Reference Line C shown in ORANGE.

I Marked 3" out from the Centre and used a 5" Circle. Begin with the size you want and mark out from the centre and choose the most appropriate Circle size to quilt your own Celtic Knots Celtic Stars.

To quilt the smaller Celtic Knot in the I marked a second Triangle 1/2" in from the first and used a 3" Circles on Quilts Circle.
