## Supplies:

- ◆ Ruler Work Foot
- ◆ Sew Steady Extension Table with Circle Sewing Features
- ◆ Circle Sewing Tool
- ◆ Sampler Set 1 Templates by Westalee Design
- ◆ Quick Easy Mitered Binding Tool by SEW BIZ
- ◆ #90 Top-Stitch Needle

## For 1 Placemat

- ◆ Fusible Fleece (I use Pellon 987 F)  
\_\_\_\_\_ 1 pc. 13" x 18" , 1 pc. 9" square
- ◆ Backing fabric - this will be brought to the front to for binding.  
\_\_\_\_\_ 1 pc. 17" x 22"
- ◆ Strips for quilting Use a variety of fabrics.  
\_\_\_\_\_ 5 strips 3" x 18" Please press fabrics **before** cutting.
- ◆ Decorative Circle  
\_\_\_\_\_ 9" square of fabric for the **circle** on the placemat
- ◆ All-Purpose thread for Strip Quilting
- ◆ Threads to contrast for quilting
- ◆ 40 wt., 35 wt. or 30 wt. Rayon or Polyester Thread for Applique' of the Circle

## For 1 Napkin

- ◆ 2—16" squares of contrasting fabrics

Starch Alternative

(Best Press or June Tailor)

Curved Needle

4" Applique' Scissors

Havel Blunt tip Snips

12 1/2" Centering Ruler by SEW BIZ

Clover Chaco Liner Pen refilled with

Pounce Iron-off Chalk

Point Turner

Pinking Shears

You will also need to have an iron and ironing surface.
