






The suggested marking tools for the Wholecloth Quilt are not required but will produced the best results. They include:

- 1. DMQuilting BASIC MARKER 4"x12" or
- 2. DMQuilting BASIC MARKER 12"x12"
- 3. Westalee Design 12.5" or 8.5" 8-Point Marking Square
- & Westalee Design 12.5" or 8.5" 6-Point Marking Square

OPTIONAL: Westalee Design ULTIMATE 24 Marking Square







Quilting Templates used for this demonstration include the following:

- 1. DMQuilting 5.5" RIBBONS & BOWS
- 2. DMQuilting 8.5" RIBBONS & BOWS
- 3. DMQuilting 11.5" WREATH RIBBONS & BOWS










## **STEP 3.2-A**


**About this Block** ... This circular design is quilted in two parts. First part, Unit A, uses **5.5" RIBBONS & BOWS TEMPLATE**. The second part, Unit B is stitched with 24 rotations using the **11.5" WREATH RIBBONS & BOWS TEMPLATE**. A rotation pin is used in the center for consistent alignment of both units. The "**STITCH & FLIP TECHNIQUE**" is used in Unit A for the center section bow but in a slightly different way than Circle #1.


### **Tools and Templates Used**

- DMQuilting 5.5" RIBBONS & BOWS
- DMQuilting 11.5" WREATH RIBBONS & BOWS
- Westalee Design Circles on Quilts (12", 12.5")
- Westalee Design 8-Point Marking Square - 8.5" or12.5"











## 11.5" WREATH RIBBONS & BOWS





## **Unit A - 6 alignment marks only** Refer to diagram **A**.


- Place 8-Point Crosshair Square at the center of the large circle.
- · Mark both HORIZONTAL slots
- Mark all four DIAGONAL slots
- DO NOT MARK THE VERTICAL SLOTS






## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR DESIGN CIRCLE #2**


#### **STEP 3.2-B**

The second part, Unit B, is marked with 24 rotation marks as shown in the diagram. It is completed using the **11.5" WREATH RIBBONS & BOWS TEMPLATE** in two rounds of stitching <u>without</u> flipping the template.

- For the first round of stitching, alignment is with every other mark and stitched.
- · The second round will fill in the remaining marks and complete the interior circle.
- Overlapping stitches will occur during the completion of these 24 rotations of stitching.
   NOTE: Template is used without being flipped.


## Unit B - 24 alignment marks Refer to diagram B.


- Place 8-Point Crosshair Square at the center of the large circle to mark the outer section past Unit A..
- Mark all 8 slots and rotate the square to repeat markings on the 30 degree and 60 degree intervals totaling 24 marks.
- Extend marks to Circle edge as needed if too short to reach with square.




## Round 1 - Diagrams 1-3

- Reinsert Rotation Pin at center, place Template as shown.
- Beginning at RED \*, stitch entire interior of template stopping with needle down at the RED X.
- Rotate template skipping one mark and repeat by starting at RED \* again.
- · Repeat stitching 12 patterns completing first round of this unit.







#### Round 2 - Diagram 4

- A total of 24 stitched rotations complete this design. Refer to diagram B on side margin before beginning to stitch.
- With first round complete, continue from the RED \* and stitch the remaining 12 patterns of the second round as in Round 1.
- Stitches will overlap the previously stitched patterns of Round 1 forming the ruffle affect.
- As stitching completes, the interior circle will also be completed.
- Use Westalee Design Circles on Quilts template to complete the secondary outer circle of this unit.
- Leave thread tails and proceed to next STEP.


## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR DESIGN CIRCLE #3**

### **STEP 3.3**

**About this Block** ... This partial circle is quilted with the **11.5**" **RIBBONS & BOWS TEMPLATE**. A rotation pin is used in the center for consistent alignment. Once all stitching is complete, the 1/2" Crosshatching is created using the **STRAIGHT AWAY TEMPLATE**.


## **Tools and Templates Used**

- DMQuilting STRAIGHT AWAY
- DMQuilting WREATH RIBBONS & BOWS 11.5"
- Westalee Design Circles on Quilts (6", 6.5")
- Westalee Design 6-Point Marking Square - 8.5" or12.5"











#### 11.5" WREATH RIBBONS & BOWS




Position <u>6-Point Crosshair Marking Square</u> as shown in Diagrams A & B. Mark 3 slots on lower right side as shown. Rotate marking square and align with previous marks to add remaining markings. Diagram B shows placement of all 5 alignment marks.


Insert pin at center of markings to stitch using **WREATH RIBBONS & BOWS 11.5 Template.** Follow placement diagrams 1-8 below. Template is FLIPPED to stitch patterns 5-8.

 Circles on Quilts Template can be used to complete the stitched circle as needed.











Complete the design with diagonal 1/2" crosshatch stitching by using the **STRAIGHT AWAY Template**. Follow Marking and Template Placement in Diagrams 1-2.

Diagram 3 shows completed design with crosshatch stitching.
