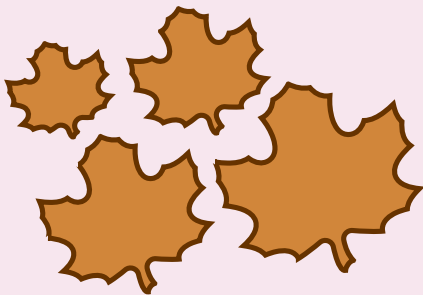
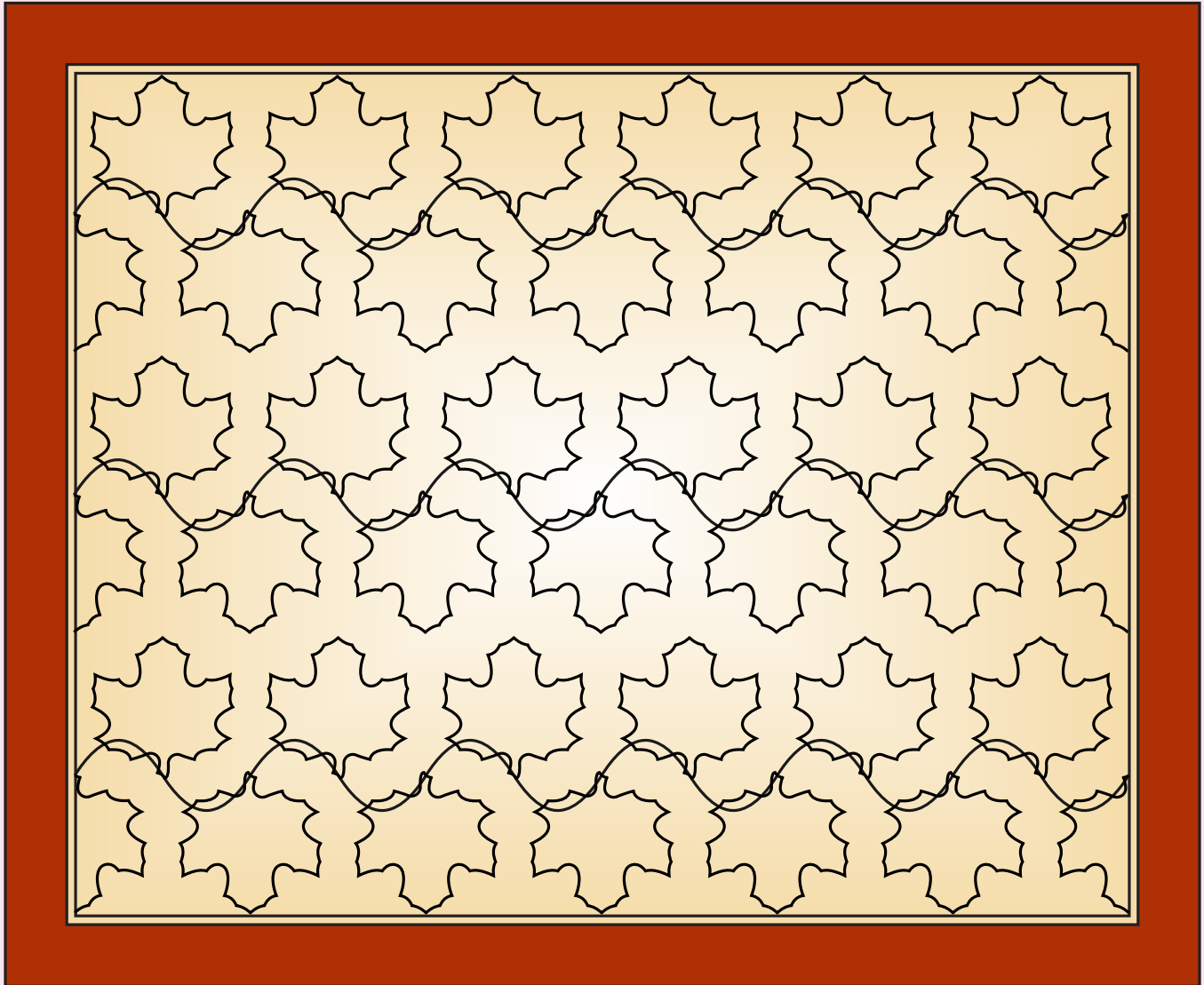

Edge-to-Edge Quilting Sample Size: Approximately 34"x28"



For this Sample Size finished approx 34"x28" with 2" borders,

Templates Used:

- **DMQ MAPLE LEAF TEMPLATE - 4"**
- **DMQ LEAFLETS TEMPLATE - 2.5"**

Optional Tools - **DMQ Basic Marker 4"x12"** or **12"x12"**

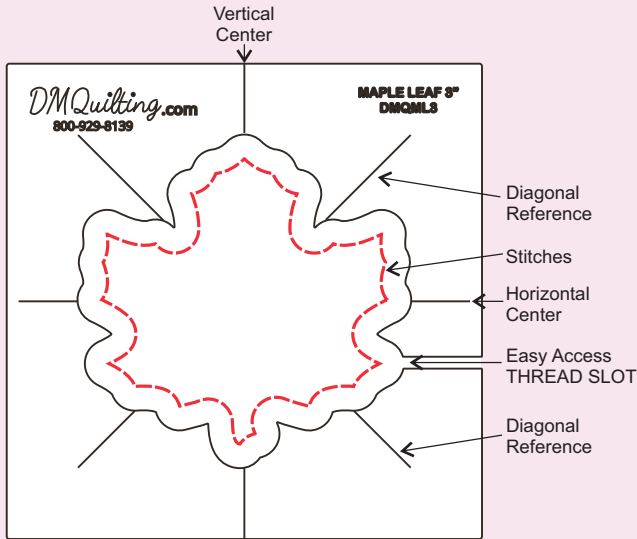
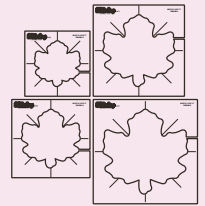
Fabric Required:

- Cut 1 Front @ 30.5" x 24.5"
- Cut border strips 2 @ 2.5" x 24.5" & 2 @ 2.5"x36"
- Cut 1 each Back & Batting @ 36" x 30"
- Cut 3-4 binding strips @ 2.5" x WOF

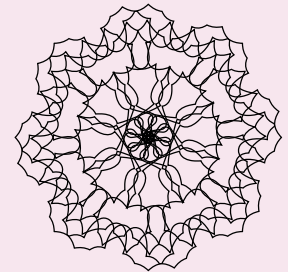
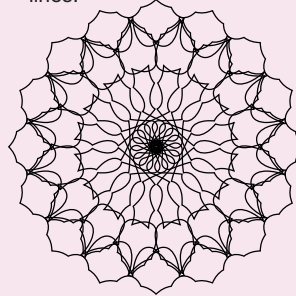
Attach borders using 1/4" seams, press seams toward borders and prepare for quilting. Quilt, trim and apply binding.

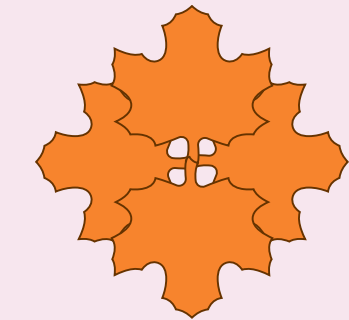
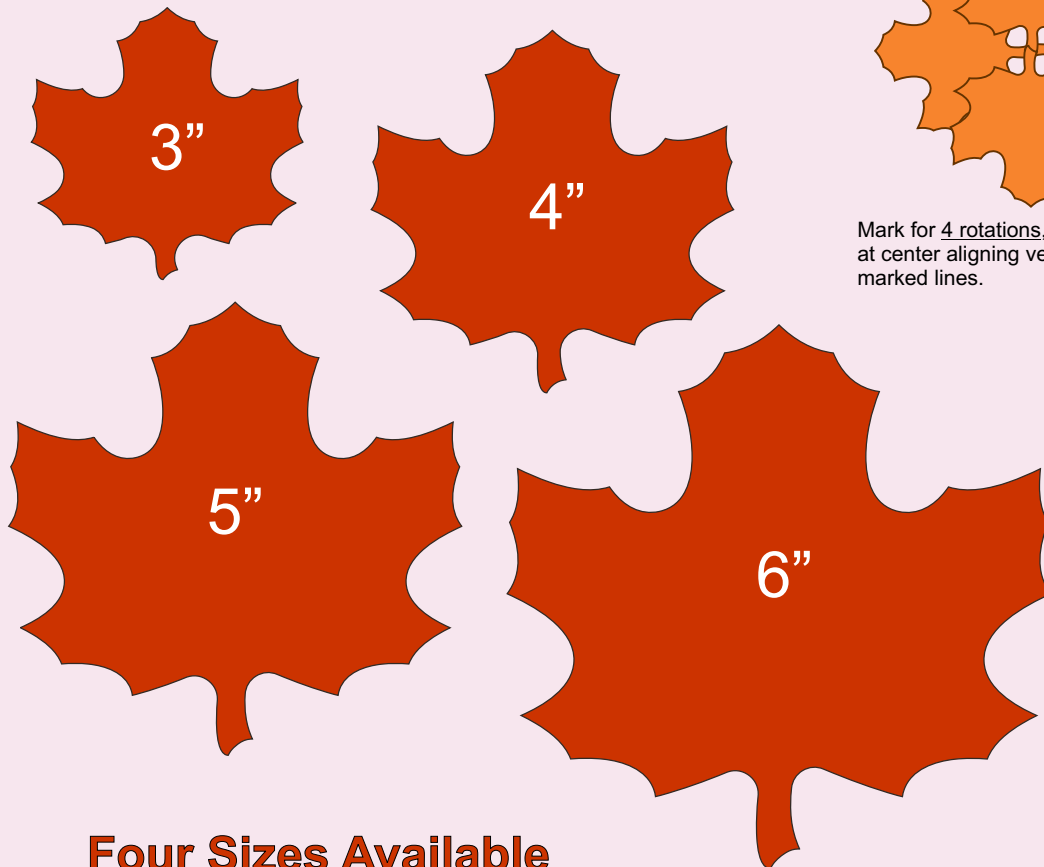
Design Options



Mark for 16 rotations, stitch with stem at center aligning vertical center with marked lines.



Mark for 8 rotations, stitch with stem at center aligning vertical center 1/4" away from marked line in each direction creating the offset patterns.

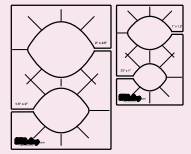


Mark for 4 rotations, stitch with stem at center aligning vertical center with marked lines.

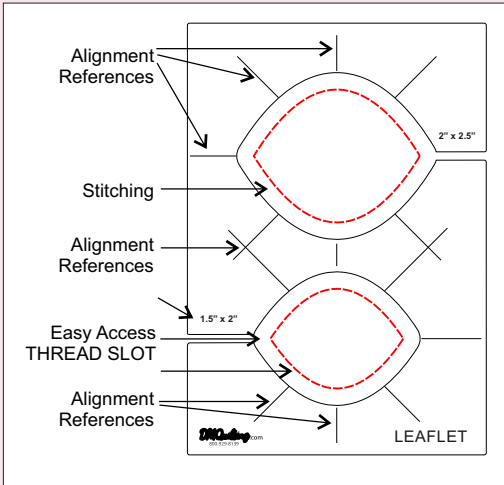

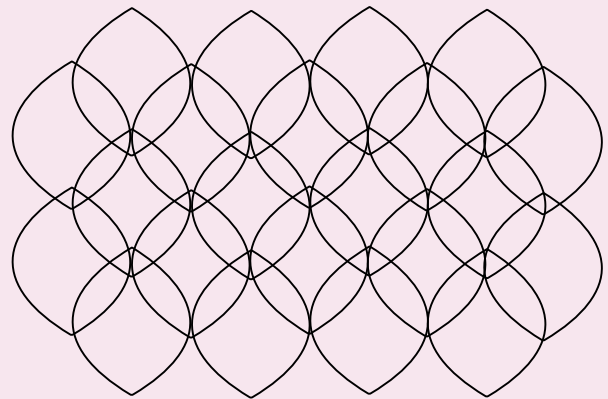
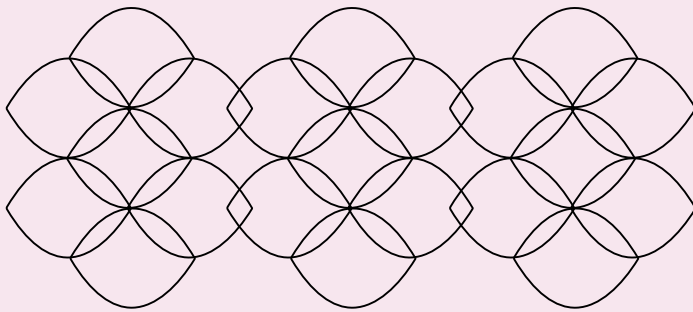


Lovely Vine Work

Create beautiful vines using single side of template and alternating sides for each unit.

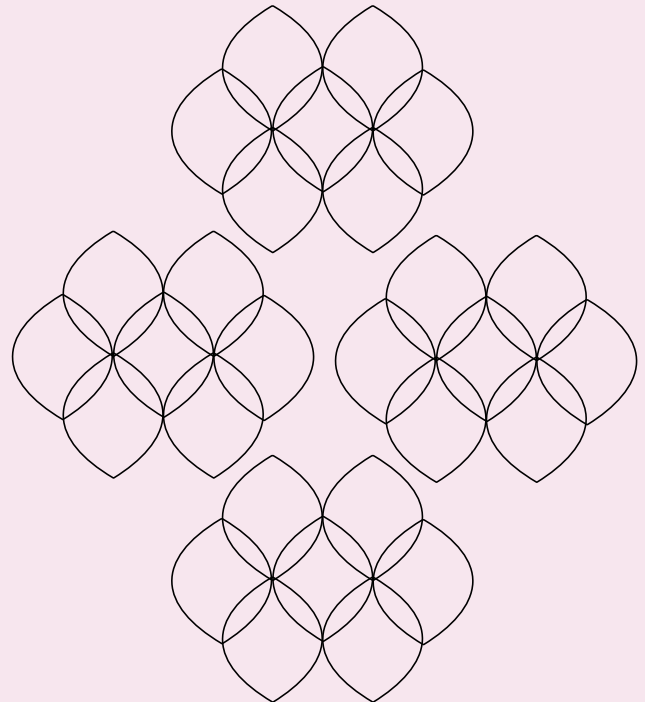
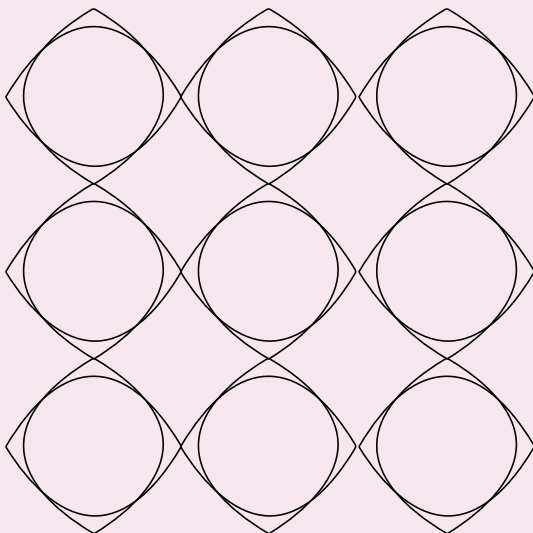

Edge to Edge Quilting Instructions

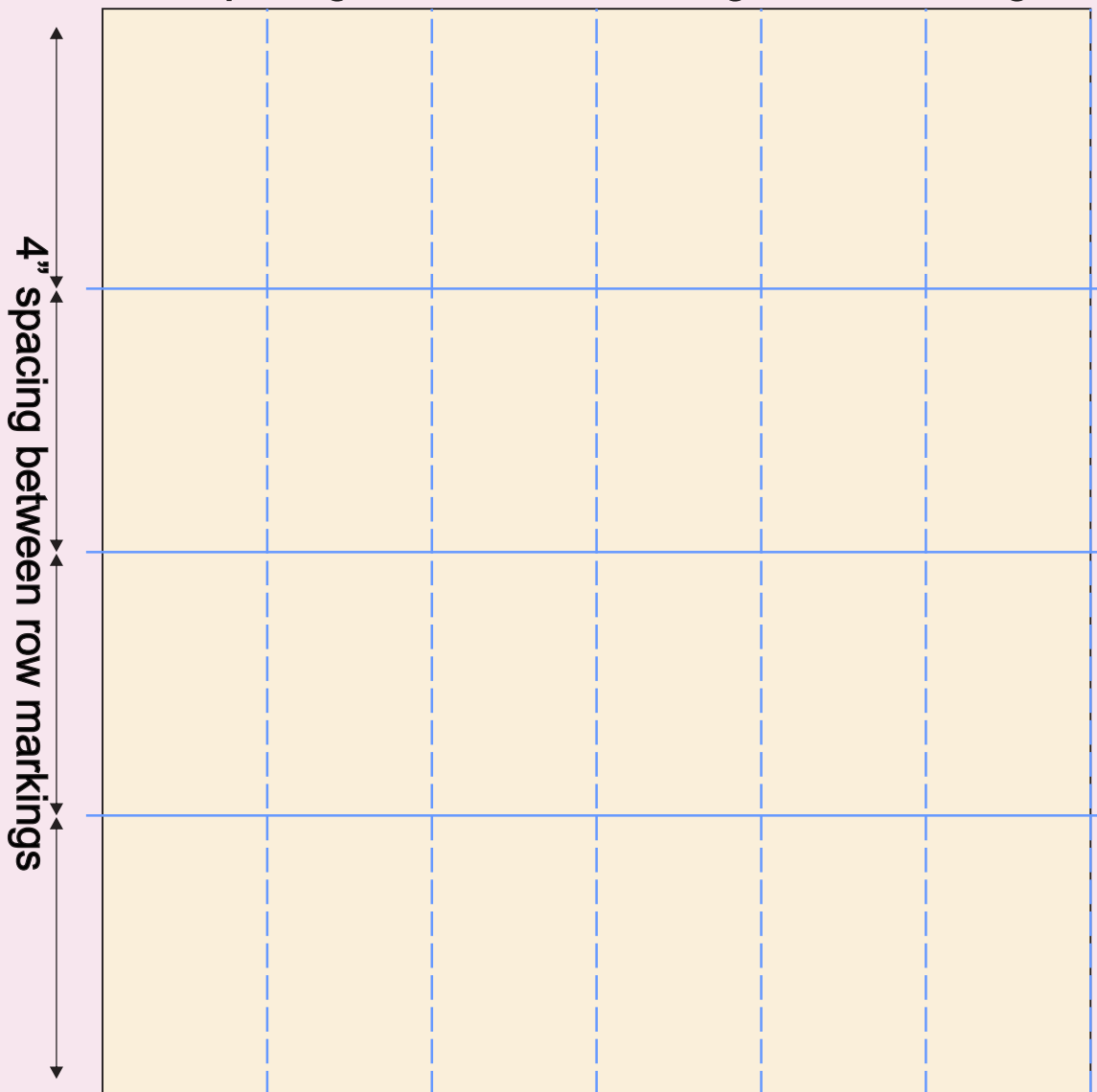


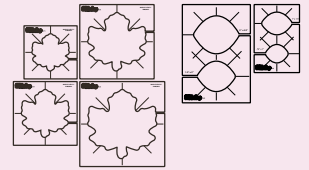
GETTING READY:

With quilting area layered together, lightly mark a grid as shown to aid in alignment. Full markings for the entire project is not needed but those at intersections are very helpful Use the BASIC MARKER for best placement of the marked lines. Verify complete removal of markings method before proceeding.

1. Mark the horizontal lines at 4" intervals. These are used for the Leaflets vine pattern.
2. Add dashed vertical markings at 2.5" intervals to be used for centering the Maple Leaf template on the vine.
3. Stitching will begin in the upper left corner and progress across the horizontal row completing an 8" vertical span as you quilt.

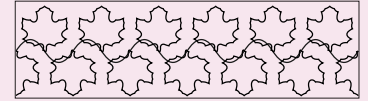
2.5" spacing between vertical alignment markings

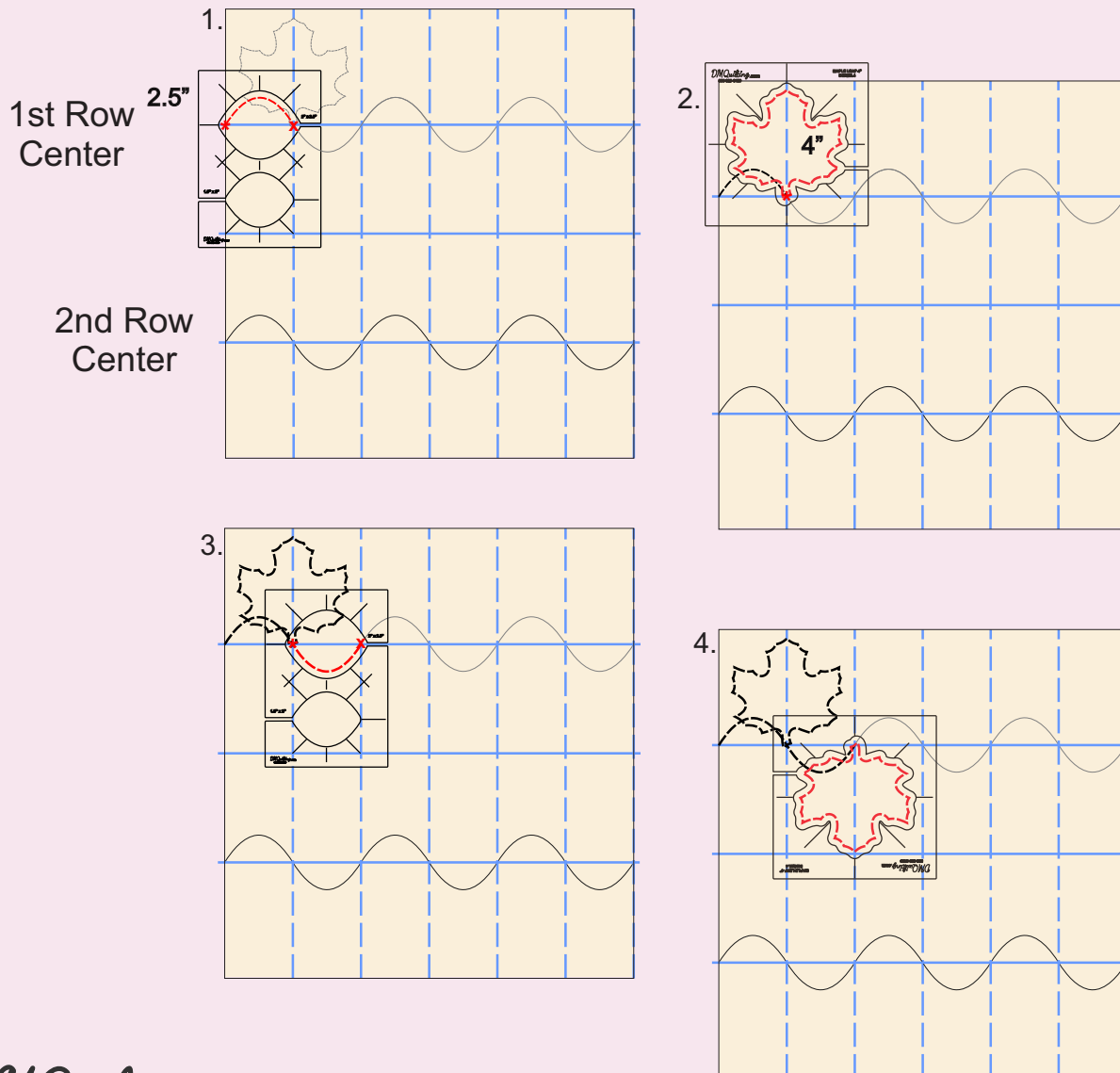
Edge to Edge Quilting Instructions

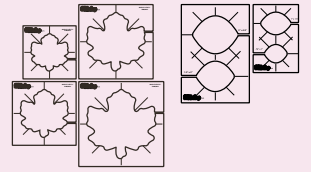


QUILTING PLAN:

1. Position the **2.5" LEAFLETS template** as shown and begin stitching at the **RED ***. Stop at the **RED X** to stitch a partial pattern of the template. Remove template.
2. Position and align the **4" MAPLE LEAF template** as shown and stitch the full interior pattern stopping at the same point where stitching began at the intersection of the dashed line and the vine. Remove template.
3. Reposition the LEAFLETS template to stitch the opposite side of the partial pattern creating the lower curve of the vine element of the design. Remove template.
4. Reposition the MAPLE LEAF template for the next leaf pattern with the template rotated 180 degrees or completely upside down. Refer to diagrams. Stitch full pattern stopping at the starting point and remove template.

Proceed with these four steps to complete partial and full patterns across the upper and lower portions of each row. At the beginning or ending of the lower half of each row, a partial (or vertical half) leaf pattern to fill the space may be added as desired. Each complete row will fill an 8" vertical span when using the 4" template.
