## Supplies Needed

#### Westalee Tools Used:

- Westalee Apple Core Templates
- Templee Fuse
- The Westalee Bound to Fit Tool
- Clover Chalco Liner
- Maybe some other arcs like the mini multi arc if needed and a Straight Ruler or the 12" Arc
- Sew Biz Centering Ruler

#### **General Sewing Supplies**

- 12" Square Fabric Sandwich with background fabric choice
- 6" Square Gold for A and the Plus Sign+
- 5" Square Red for Apple
- 4" Square Green for leaves
- Scrap brown for Apple Stem
- For applique Top Threads should match your applique colors. (Gold will be demo'd in class.)
- 1 12" square of batting for Trapunto technique
- Printout of Letter A and Plus Sign sized to your preference (About 3" square)
- Printout of an Apple sized to your preference (About 3" square)
- Pencil
- Iron and Safe Surface for Fusible
- Scissor for Trapunto technique
- Thread for quilting. (50wt So Fine is used in the sample.)
