

How to Read the Template


3" Wide - Tree at base

5" Tall - Tree tip to base without Trunk

6" With Trunk

1" Star

.25" & .5" Diameter Circles








Stitch Path without trunk

When stitching Circular Patterns, mark for number of rotations needed.

- Tree trunk may or may not be included in the stitch pattern.
- Stitching without trunk is completed by beginning at center of base stitching to tip and back to center across trunk path prior to rotating template.
- Stitching with trunk begins at bottom of trunk to tree tip and back to bottom of trunk prior to rotating template.
- An alternate design method is stitched with the tip of the tree at the center of rotation point.










To create borders and fills, mark general placement lines for spacing as desired.

- Use the bottom stitch path to travel along the distance for placement of the next tree.
- This does not have to be on a seam line as a nice topstitch effect is created when the travel path is stitched.
- Placement of trees along a border can be as closed together (even overlapping) as you need for the length of the border.
- Refer to the WINTER DREAMIN' design for a sample of the trees in a wide border.









To create the various decorating designs of the tree, mark for vertical placement of the tree at desired location and stitch.

- Once Tree is formed, add elements by stitching variations of the circles and star. See drawings for placement suggestions.
- Tree can be stitched with or without the trunk and any of the elements included within the template.



















