It's Not Just A Heart

Our **HEART TEMPLATES** are designed to make it easy for you to quilt Hearts.

The **Westalee Design Library** is written to teach you how to get the most from our **HEART TEMPLATES**.

In 2007, Westalee Design began to make templates for longarm quilting, the heart was one of the shapes that I really wanted to change. Back then, hearts were quilted around the **outside** of the template and quilters found it very difficult to stitch the bottom point of the heart. Floating that 1/2" down and back up and maintaining the shape was a challenge. If they quilted **inside** the template, the point at the top of the heart had the same problem.

The answer to this problem was to stitch inside the heart using a half template and then flip the template over and stitch the other half.

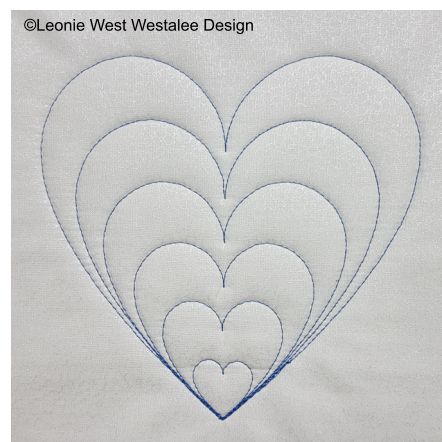
With the unique Westalee Design Foot Rest, the template has a place for you to start and stop and makes it easy to align the template for the next stitching path. Now you have easy to stitch beautiful Hearts.

Learn how to quilt Individual Hearts, Multi Hearts, TempLeeQuilt Hearts and quilt Hearts using the Westalee Design Decorative Thread Ruler Foot and decorative threads.

This Library is a design library to inspire you to create your own quilting designs (it is not a detailed instructional).

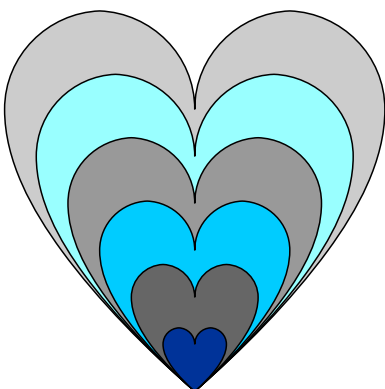
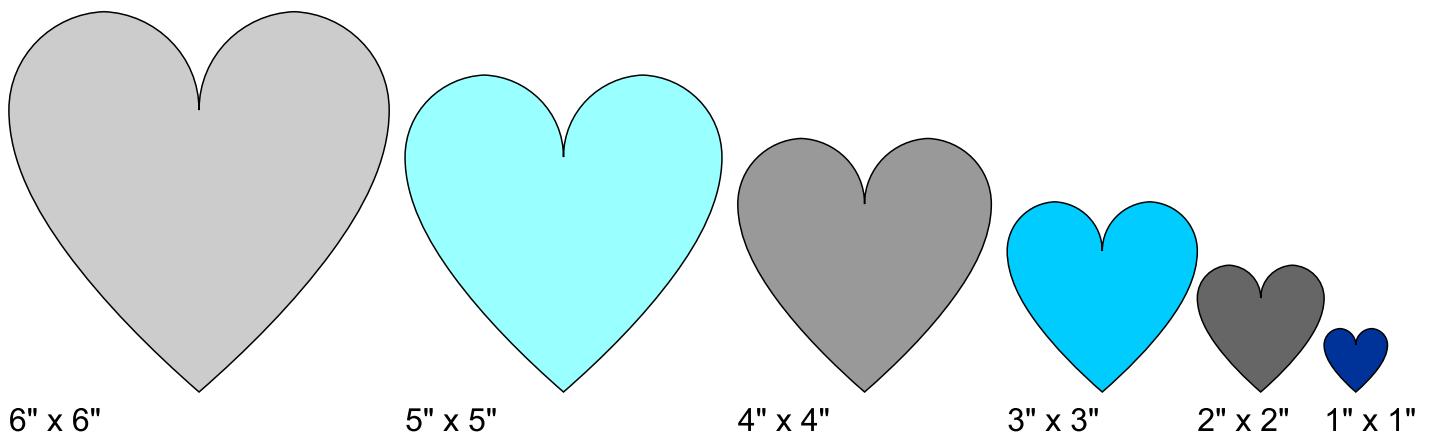
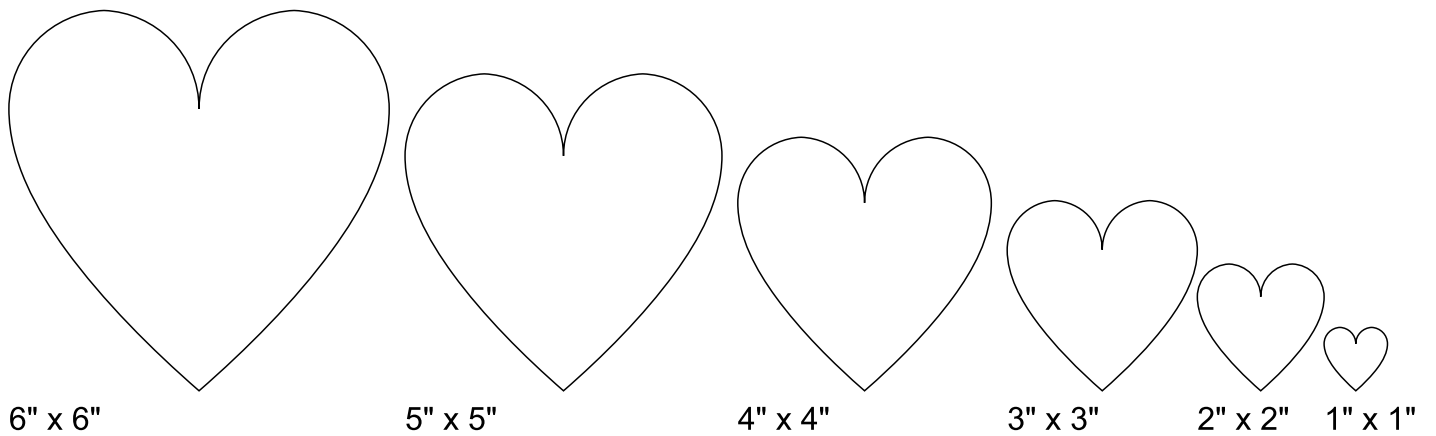

The Hearts can be used individually or in a combination of sizes can be used to create beautiful Heart designs.

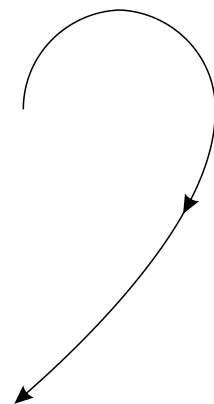
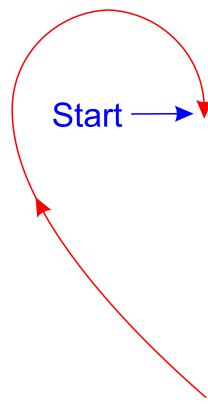
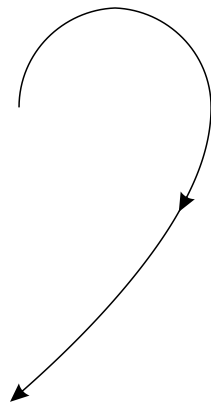
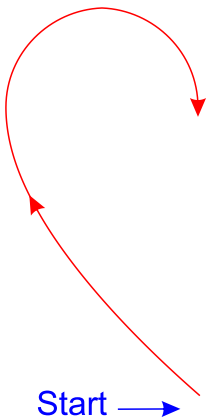
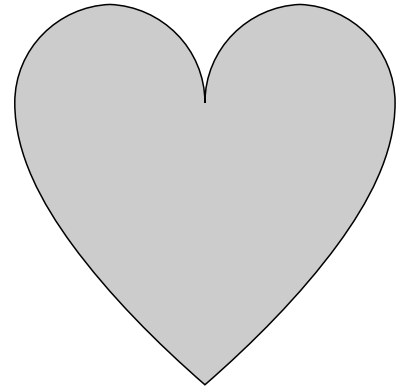
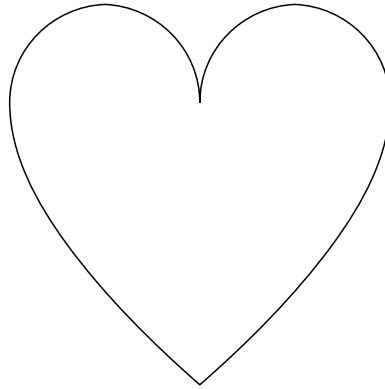
I have coloured the Hearts for you to help you easily identify the size of Heart used.



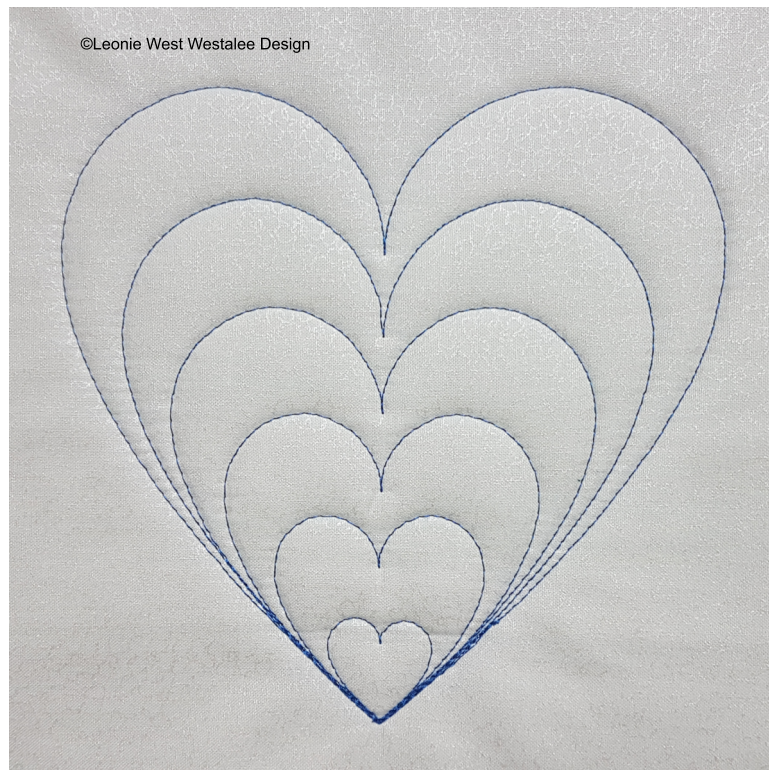
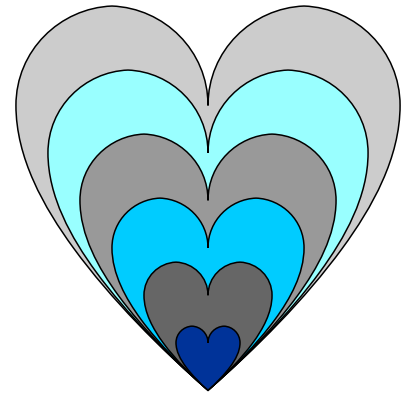
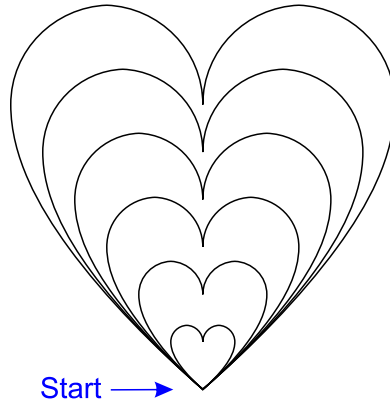

Single Hearts can be stitched starting at the top or the base.

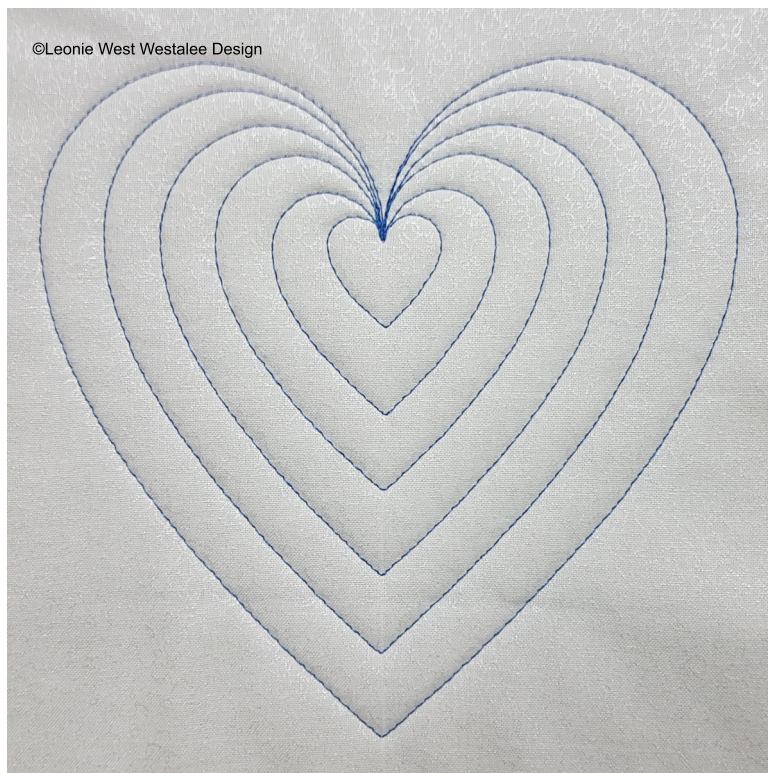
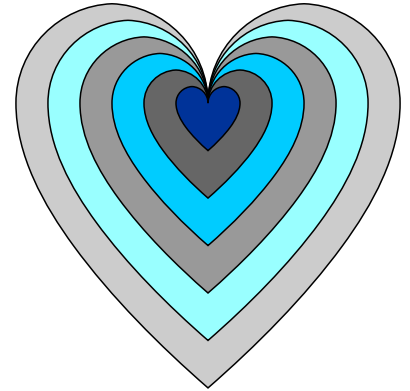
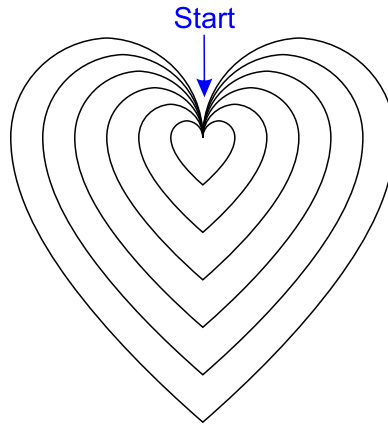

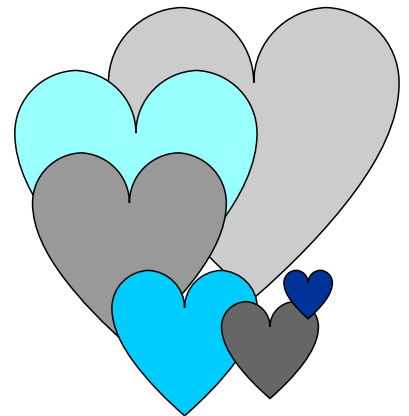
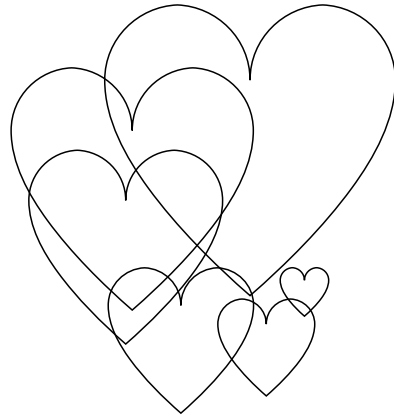
Each Heart is stitched as an individual unit - sewing in the thread tails.

Stitch the 6" Heart first.
Stitch the 5" Heart 1/2" up from the base.

Continue as shown.

TempLeeQuilt Hearts

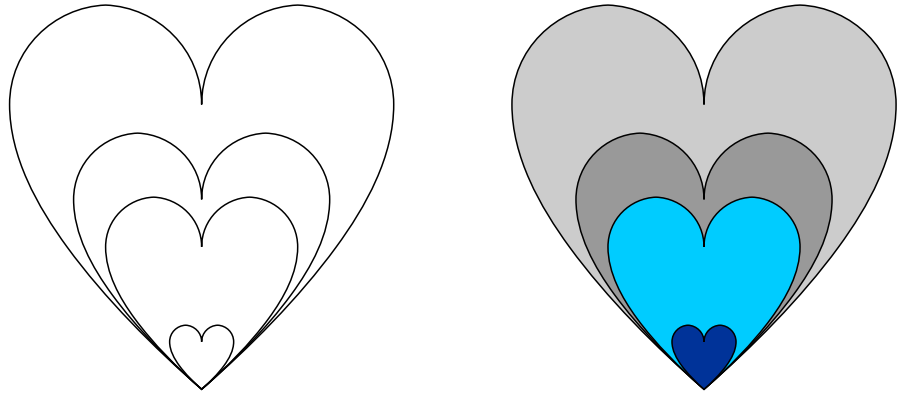


Using the Westalee Design TempLeeQuilt Technique you can applique Hearts.

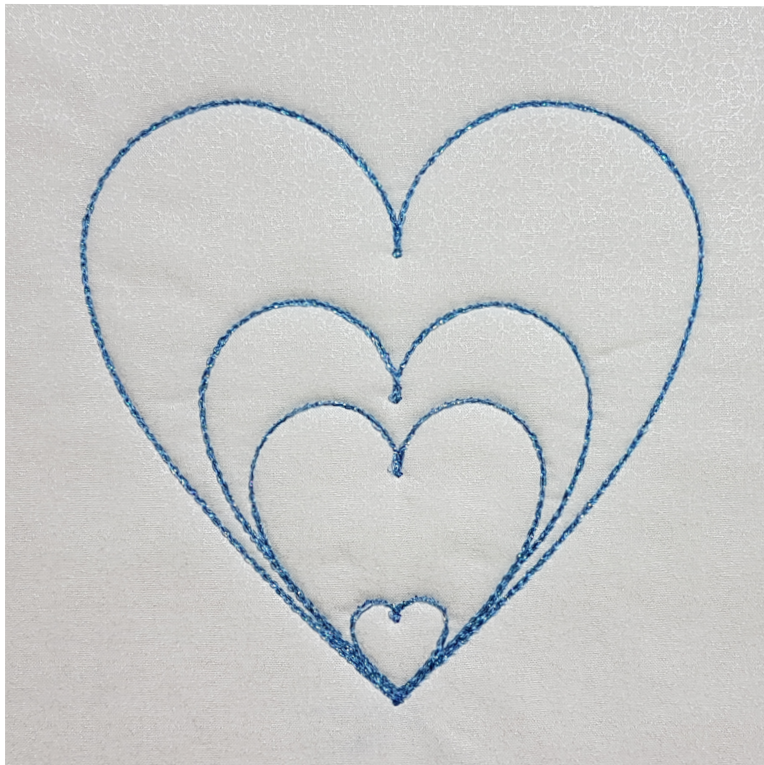
Stacked Hearts from the Base Using Different Sized Hearts



Our Hearts can be stacked from the base using 2 or more sizes. For base stacked Hearts always start at the base. I have used the 6" x 6" Heart as my largest Heart, but you could use any size as the largest heart to suit your design.

This Block was quilted using the Westalee Design Decorative Thread Ruler Foot and Leonie West's technique for quilting with Westalee Templates and Rulers using decorative threads.

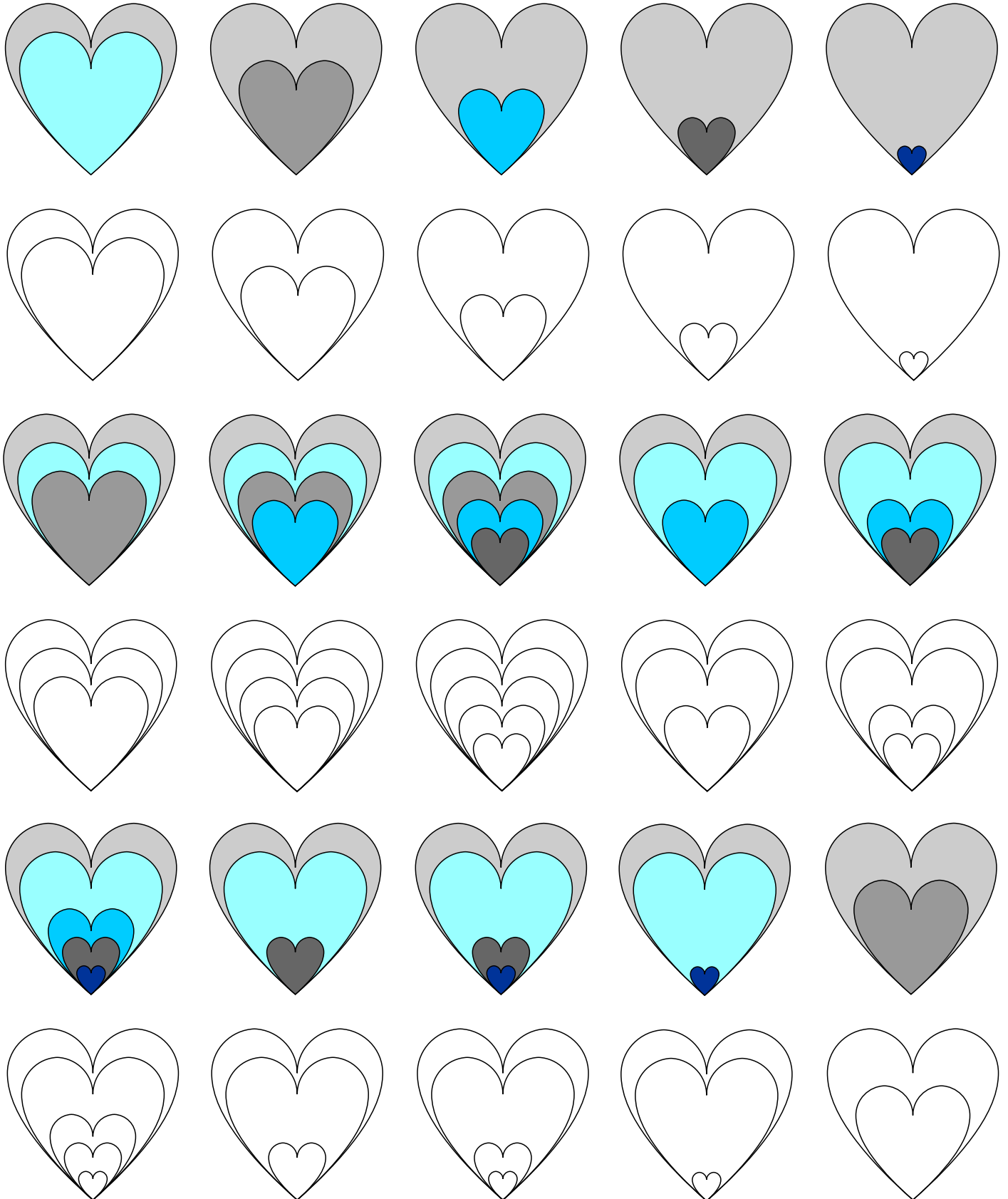
Quilted using a very small zigzag stitch and the thread used is a 1/8" metallic braid.

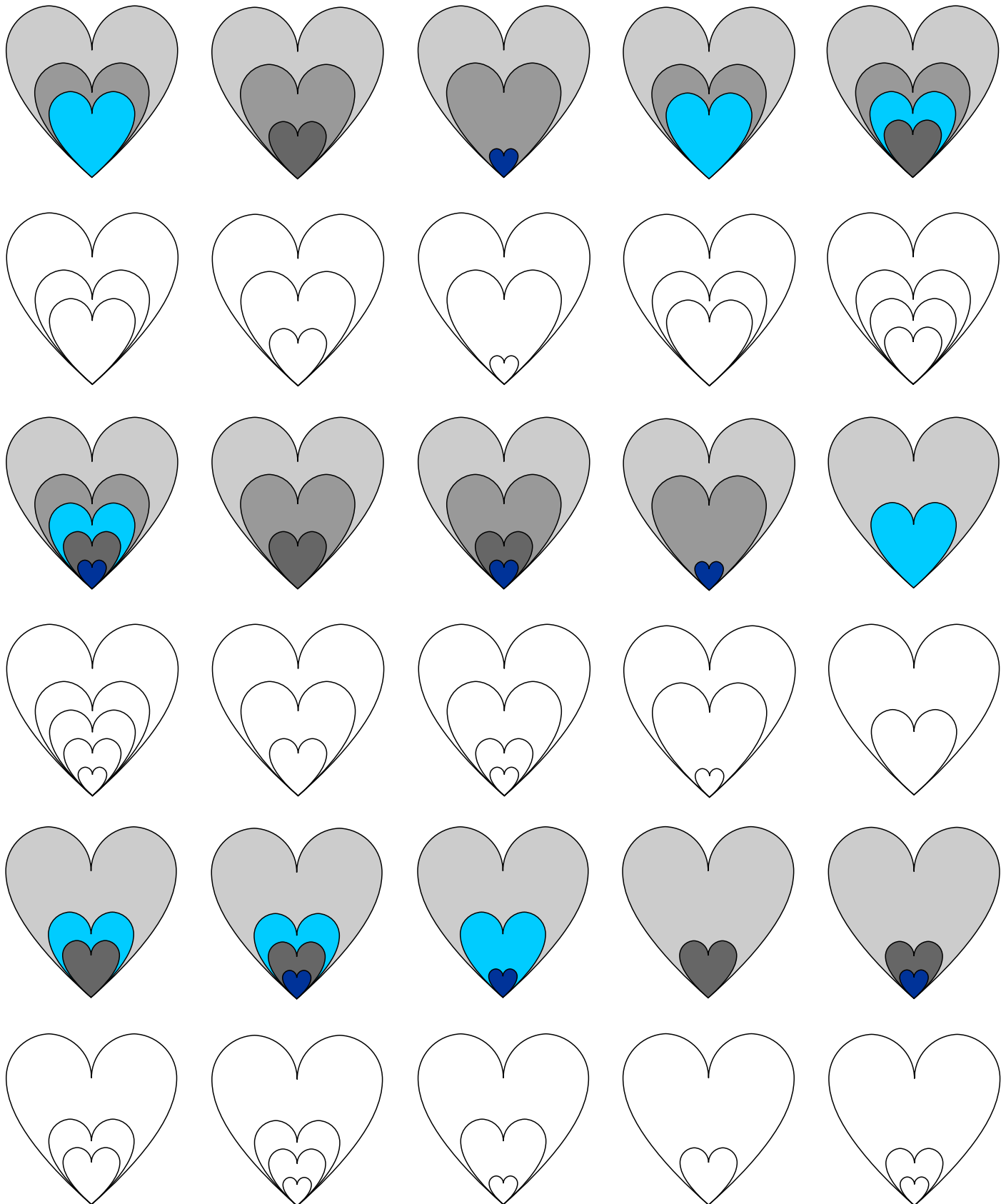

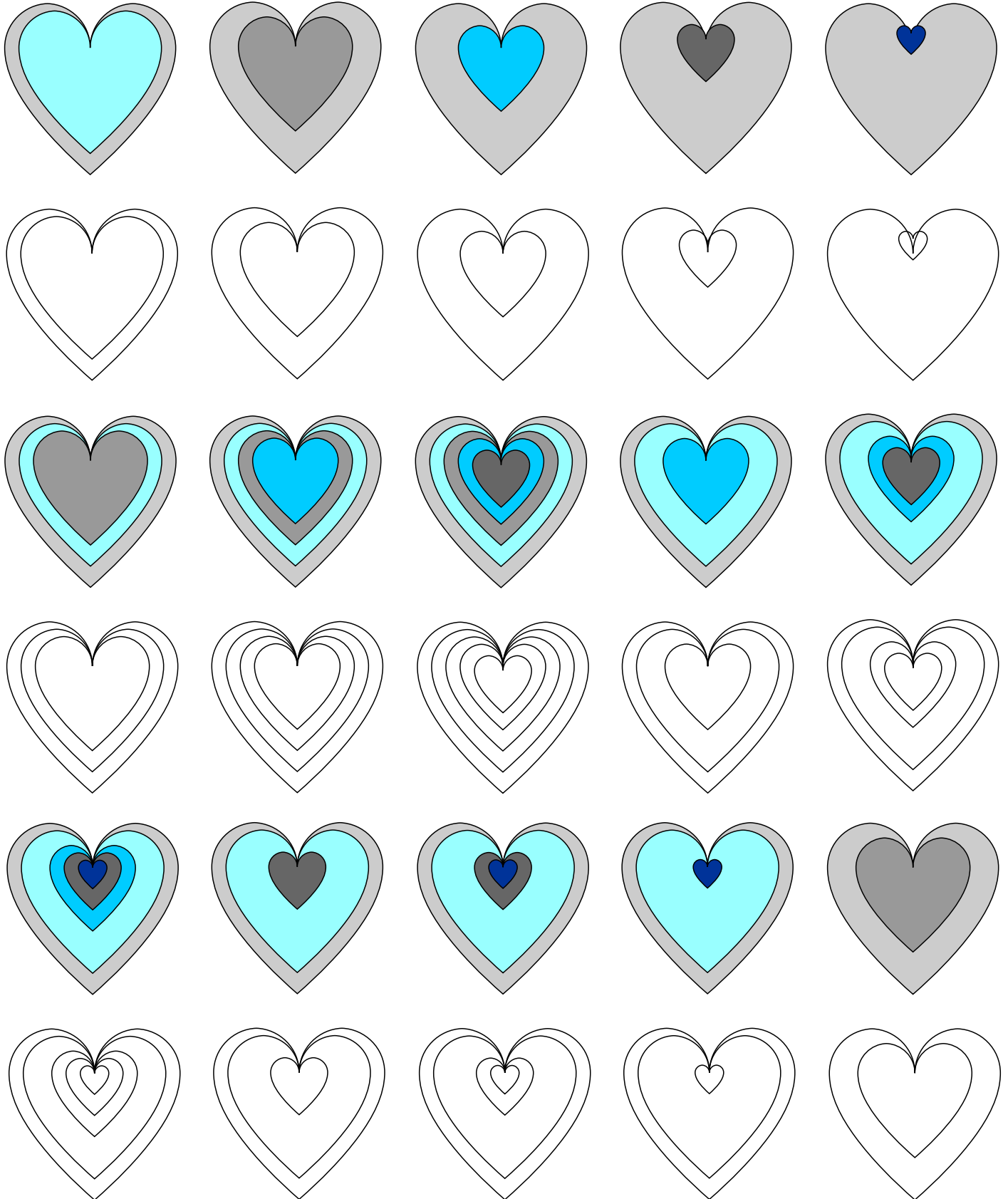

Offset Hearts



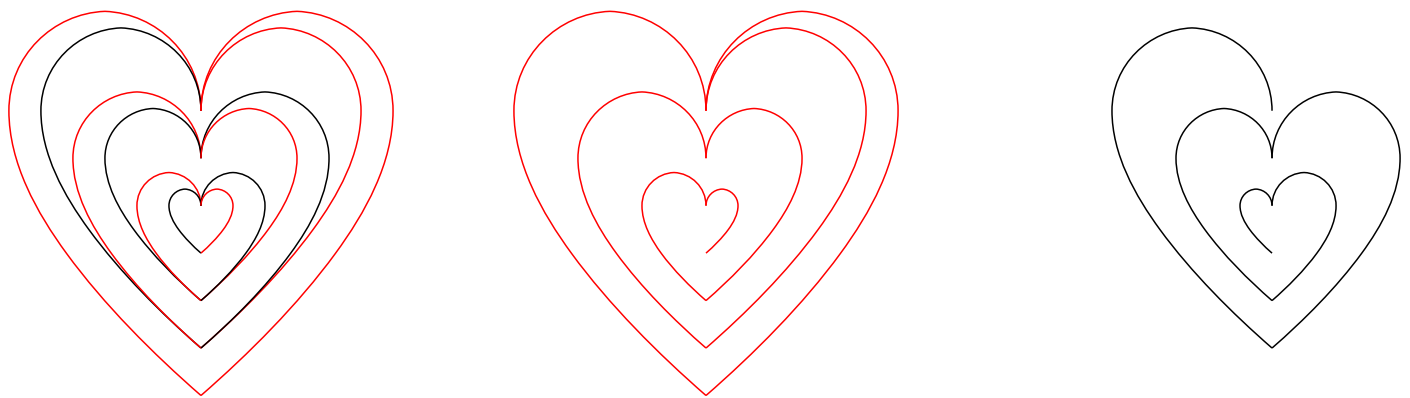
This is a really interesting design as the Hearts step from top to bottom, bottom to top.

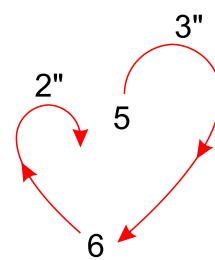
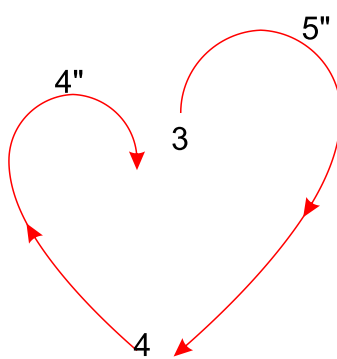
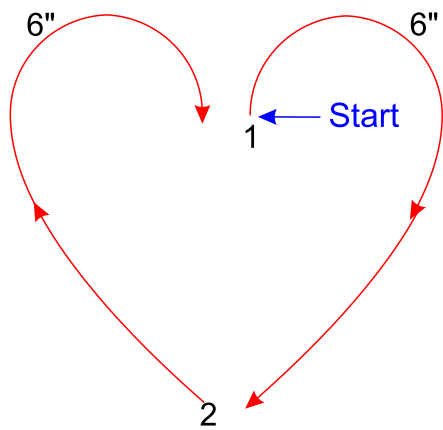
