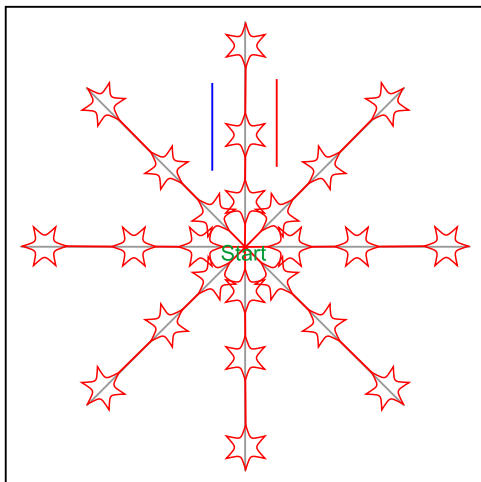
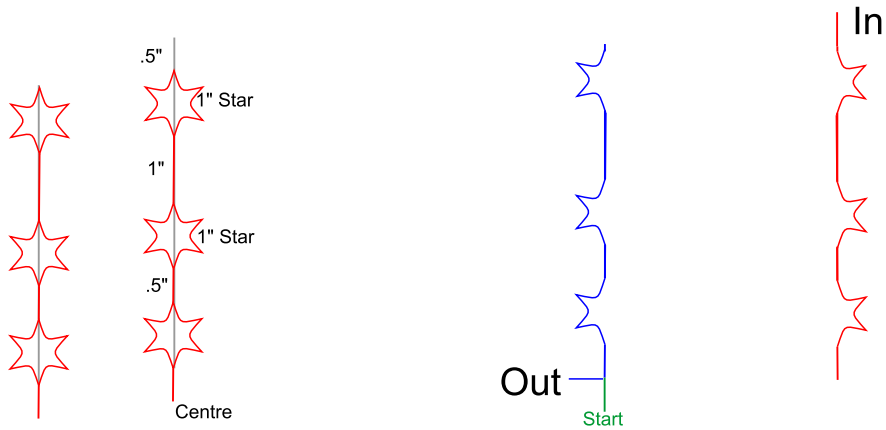


Starry Night - Star 5 - 6 Point Star Design 1

Mark required number of reference lines using the Westalee Design Crosshair Ruler. I used 8. You could use 10, 12, 16, 20, 24 or 32 depending on the finished design you want to quilt. This design is worked from the centre out.

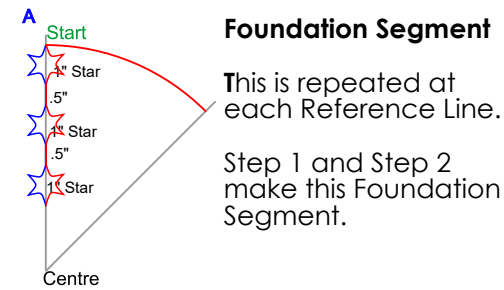
Each spike is started at the centre, 1 side is quilted working out and the second side is worked in.



Starry Night - Star 5 - 6 Point Star Design 2

Mark required number of reference lines using the Westalee Design Crosshair Ruler. I used 8. You could use 10, 12, 16, 20, 24 or 32 depending on the finished design you want to quilt. This design is created using Westalee Design Circles on Quilts and Starry Night Templates.

To locate the Starting Point A
Place the Locating Pin at the centre, place the Circles on Quilts Template on the Pin and at the 10" Circle and a reference line place the Ruler Foot at this Point A.
Slide the Circles on Quilt Template out of the way and now use the Starry Night Template to stitch the Foundation Segment



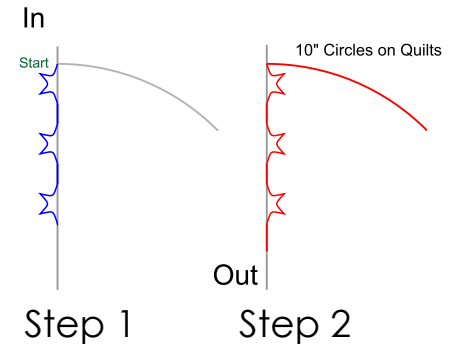
This Foundation Segment is repeated on each Reference Line.

Step 1
Stitch from A toward centre.

Step 2
Stitch from centre back to A.

Stitch the first section of the 10" Circle using Circles on Quilts to the next Reference Line.

Repeat - Step 1 and Step 2
