Fabric Needed:

Background/Gray: $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Hearts/Purple: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard

Hugs/Green: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Hugs/Yellow: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

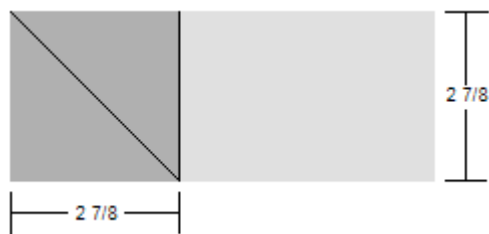
Backing and Batting; 36" Square

This gives a 2" overage on all sides.

Binding: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

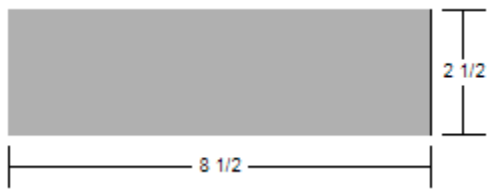
Gray Fabric / Background / Sashing



Cut 36 Triangles (Small HST)

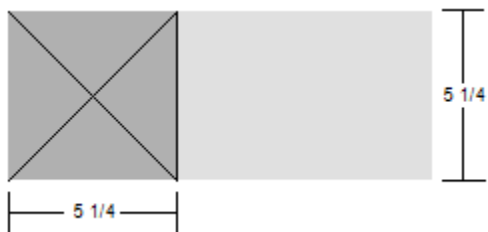


Cut 10 Triangles (Large HST)

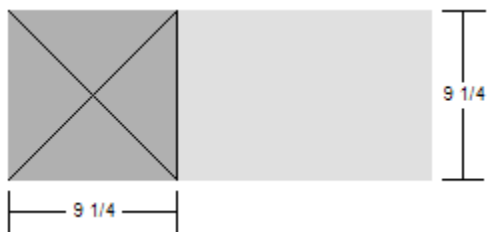


Cut 24 sashing strips

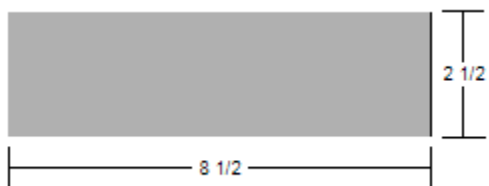
Purple Fabric / Hearts



Cut 10 Triangles (Small QST)

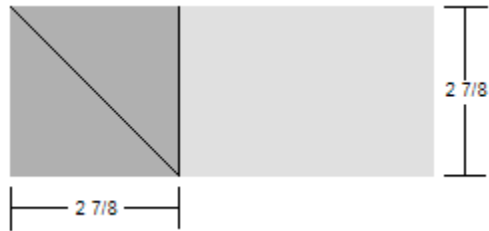


Cut 5 Triangles (Large QST)

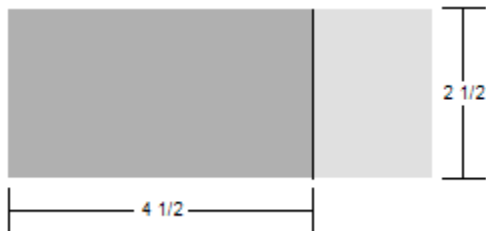


Cut 5 Rectangles

Cut 16 triangles (HST)

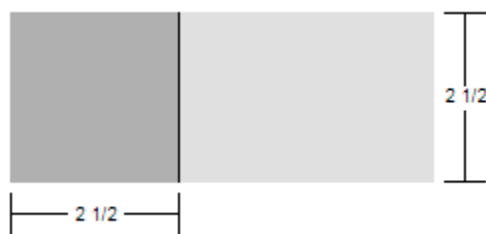


Cut 16 Rectangles

Yellow Fabric / Hugs / Cornerstones



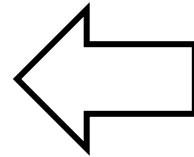
Cut 4 Squares Large



Cut 16 squares Cornerstones

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ "

The arrows designate what pieces to sew together.

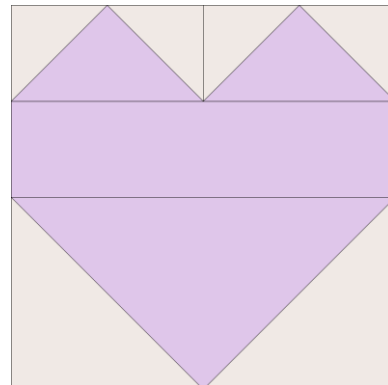


The iron designates what direction to press your seams.



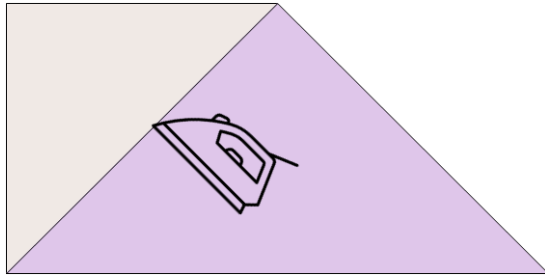
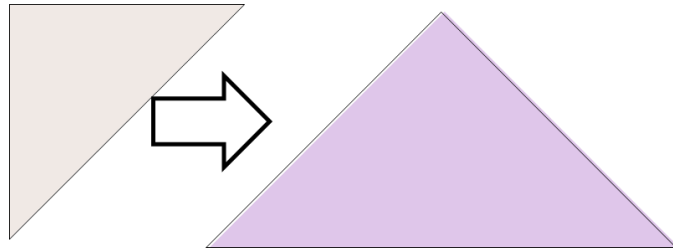
The Heart Block

There are 2 sizes of Flying Geese Units. The small Gray HST get sewn to the small purple QST.

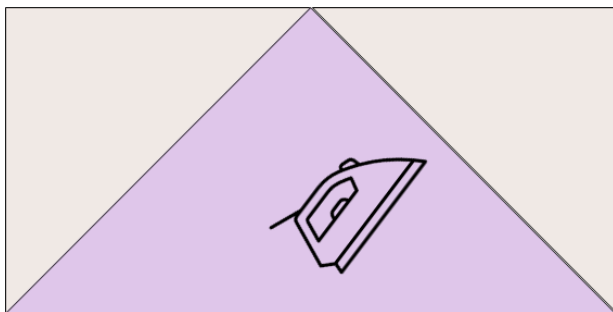
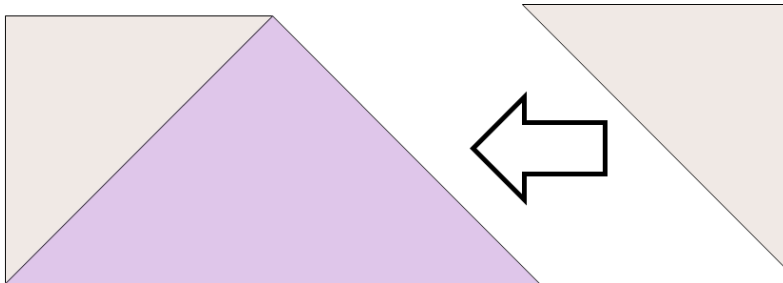


The large Gray HST get sewn to the large purple QST.

The directions are the same for both sizes.

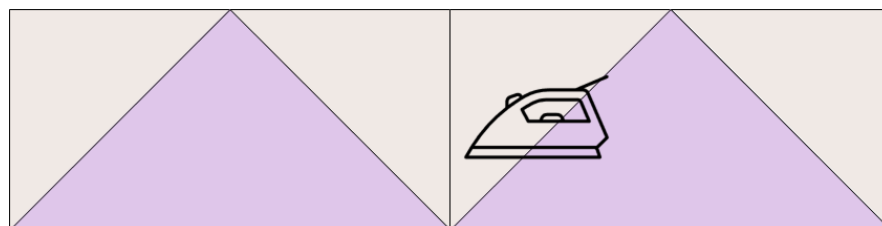
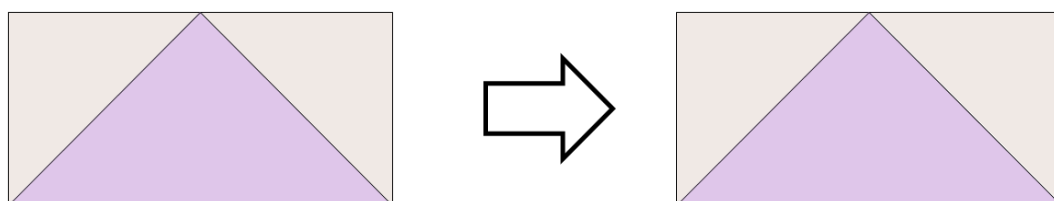


Be sure to press before adding the next HST

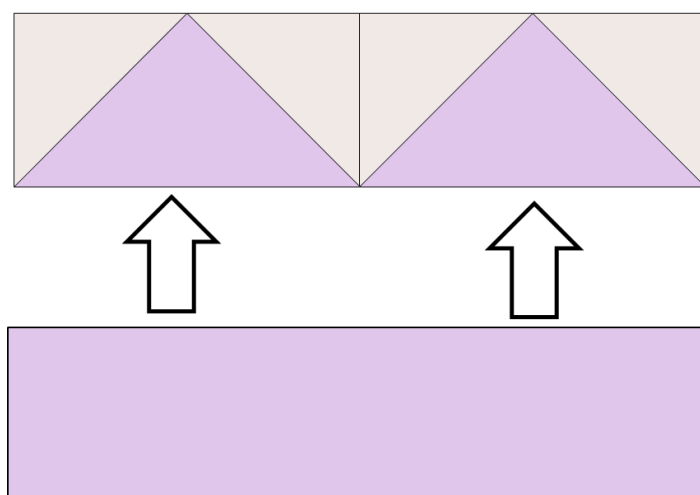


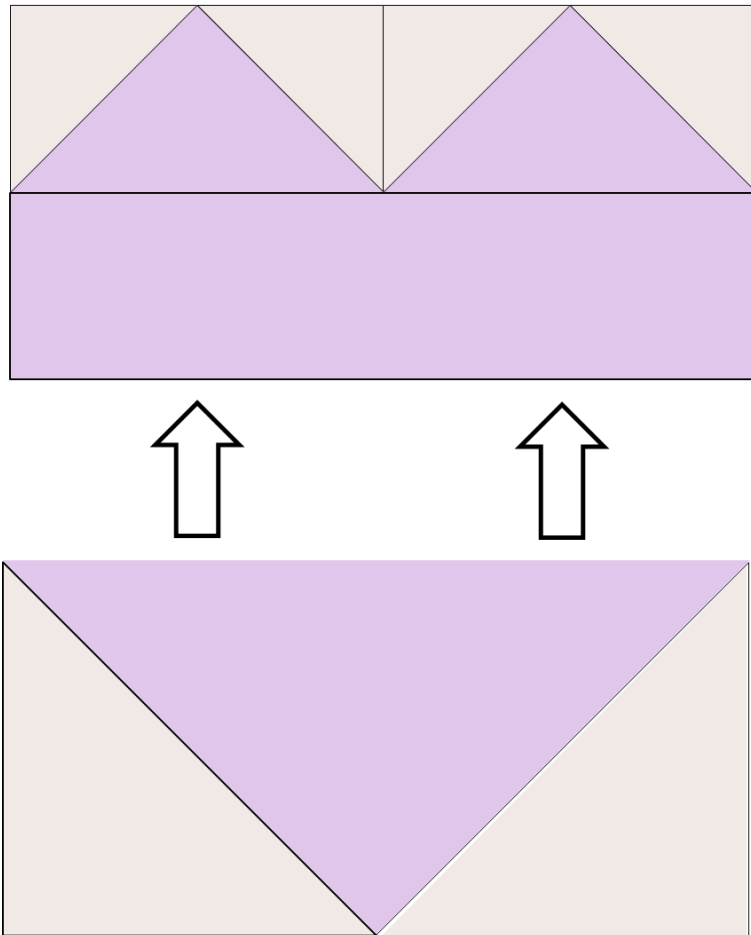
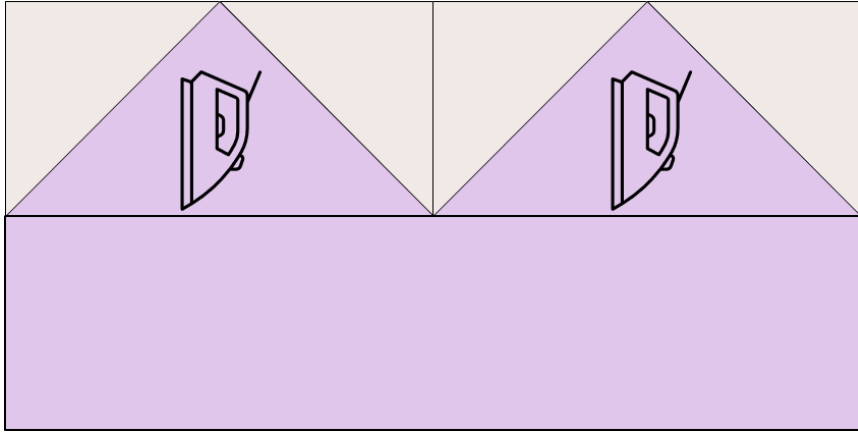
You will have 5 Large Flying Geese and 10 Small Flying Geese Units.

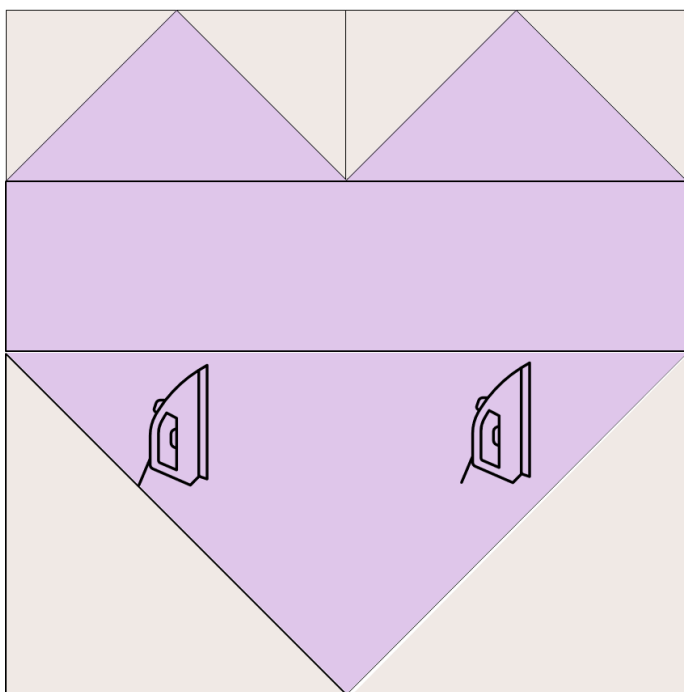
Connect the small flying geese as shown.



Construct the block.

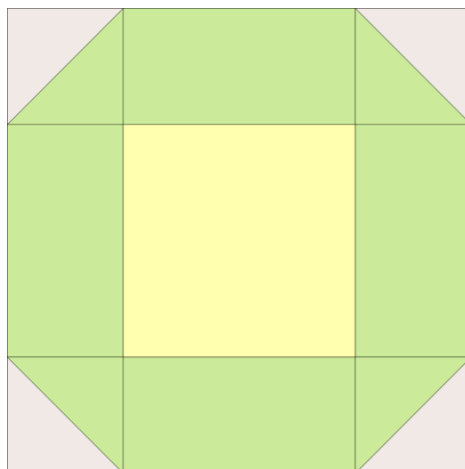




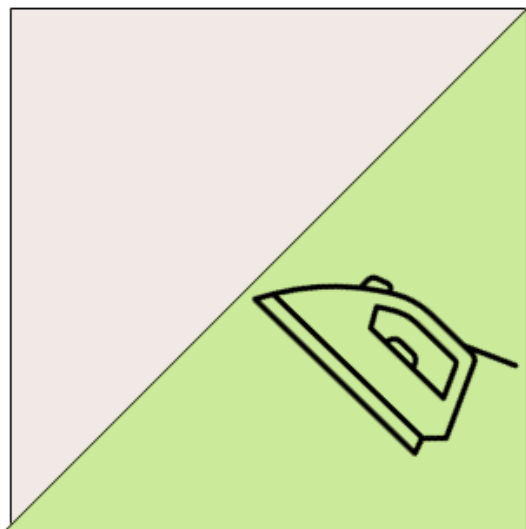
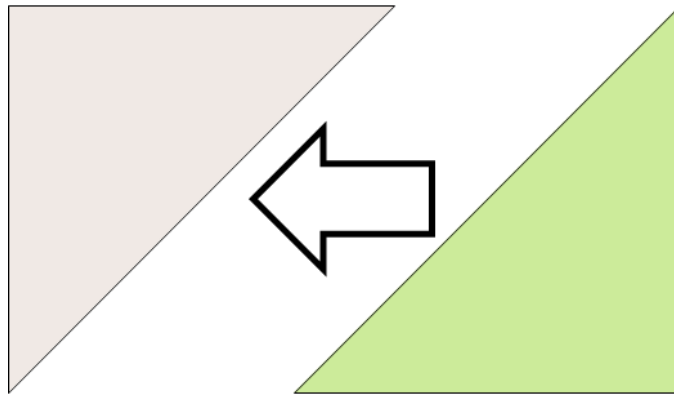


You should have 5

The Hug Block

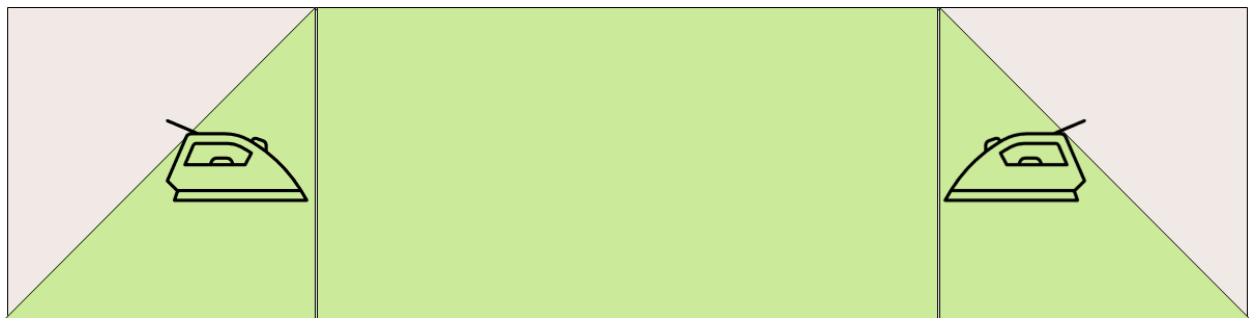


Start with the HST (Small Gray)

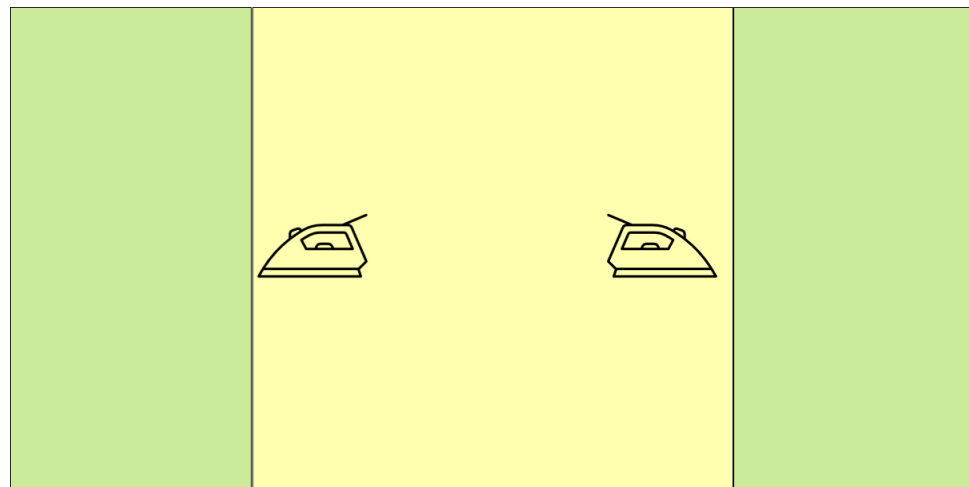
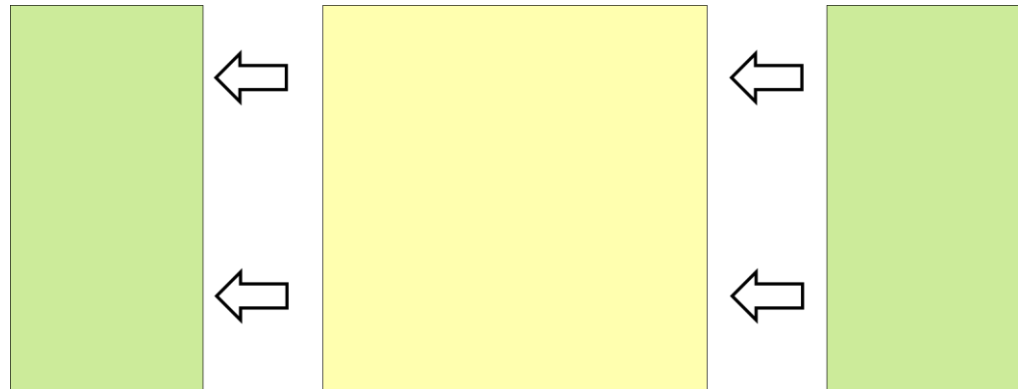


You will have 16 HST units

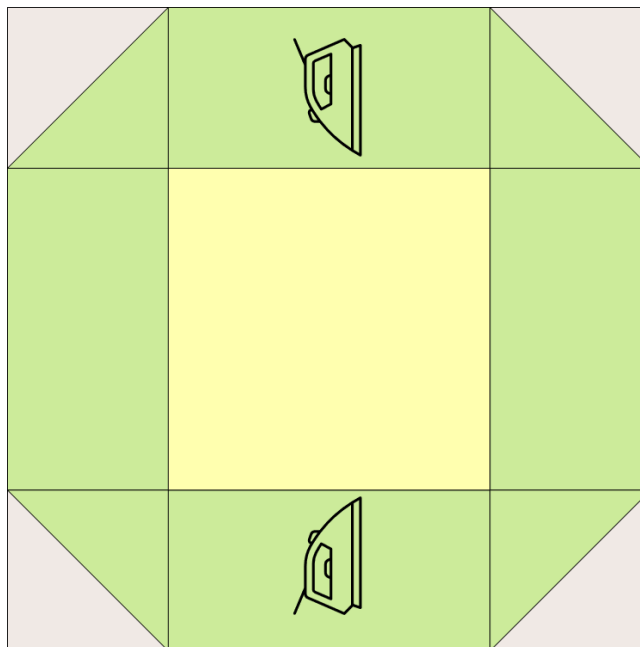
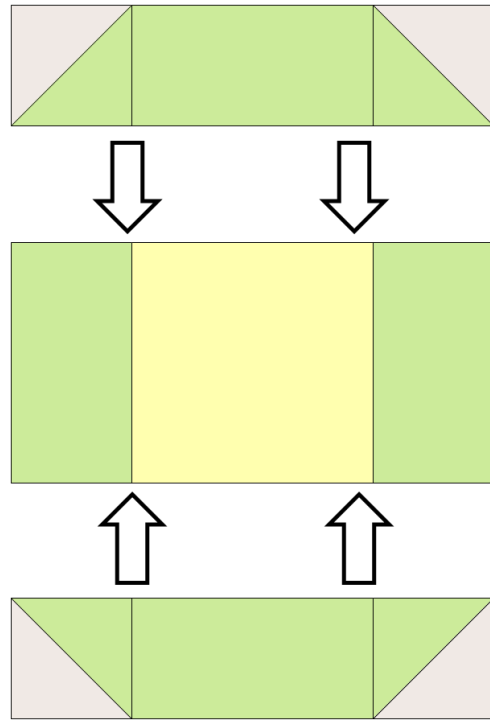
Take 8 green rectangles and attach the HST units as shown. Pay attention to the orientation of the HST.



Using the Large Yellow Squares, attach the green rectangles as show.

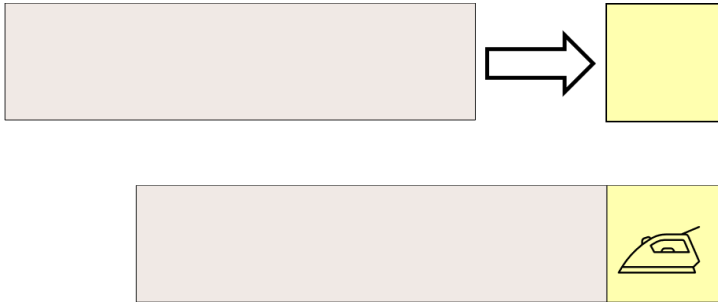


Put it all together as shown.



You will have
4 Hug blocks.

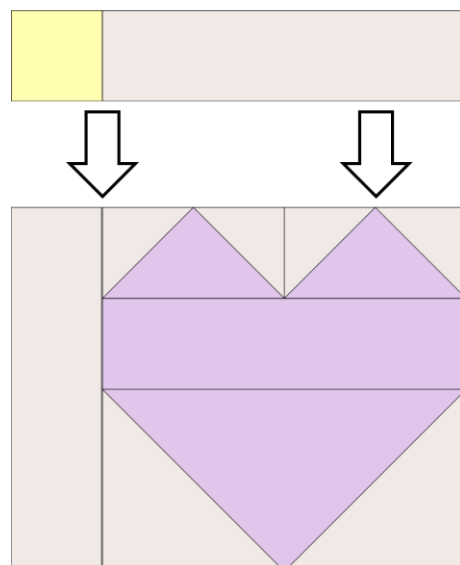
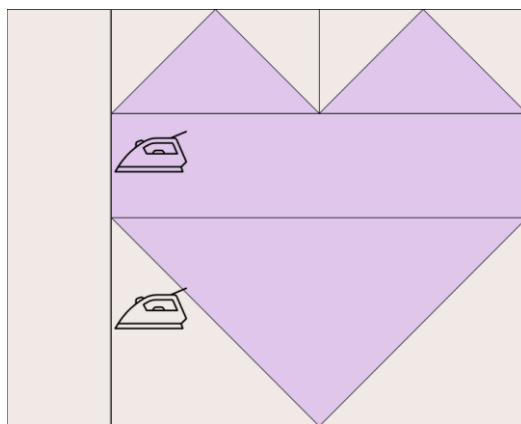
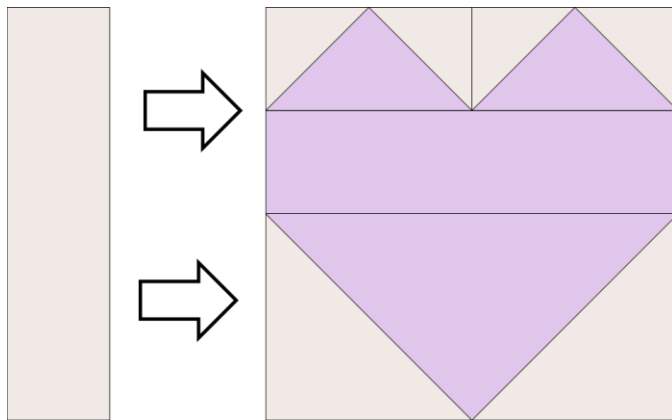
Take 15 sashing strips and add cornerstones as shown.

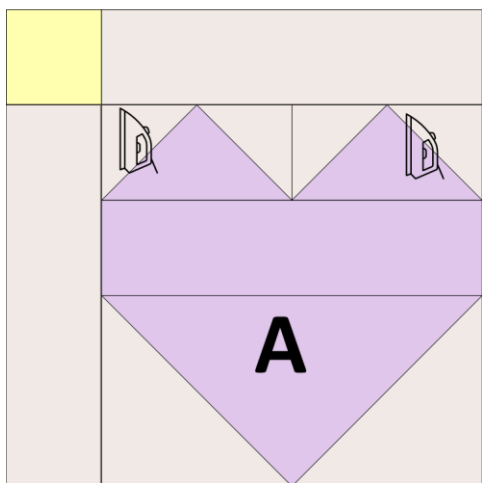


Take 1 of the sashing/cornerstone units and add another cornerstone as shown.

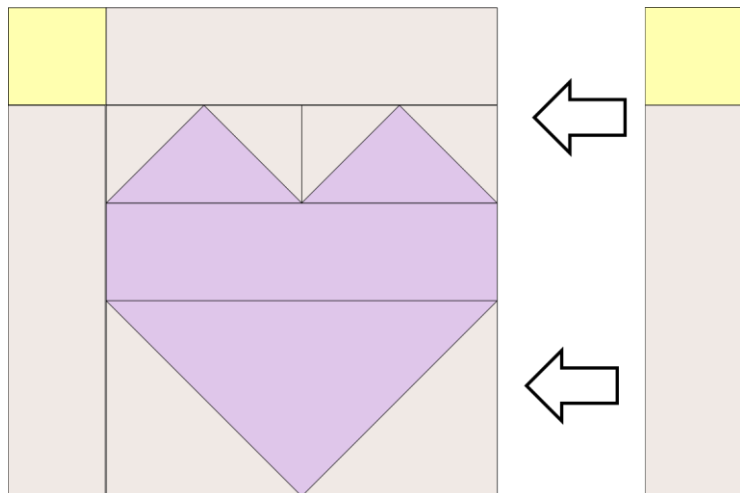


Take all Heart Blocks and add sashing as shown.

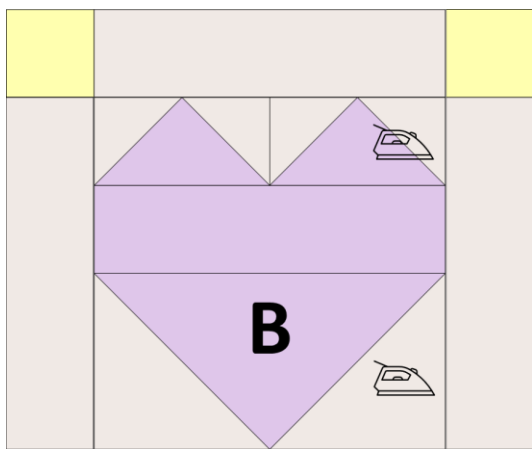




Set 2 aside and
label them **A**

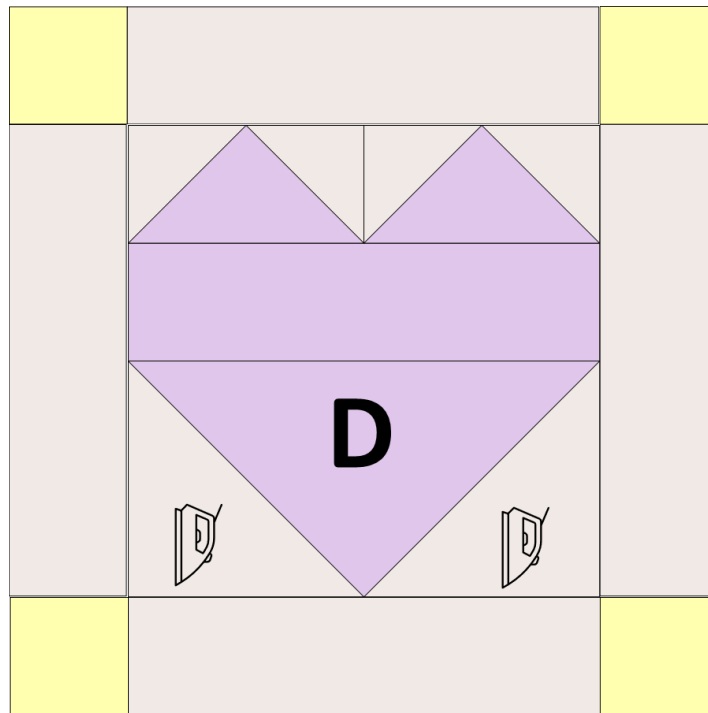
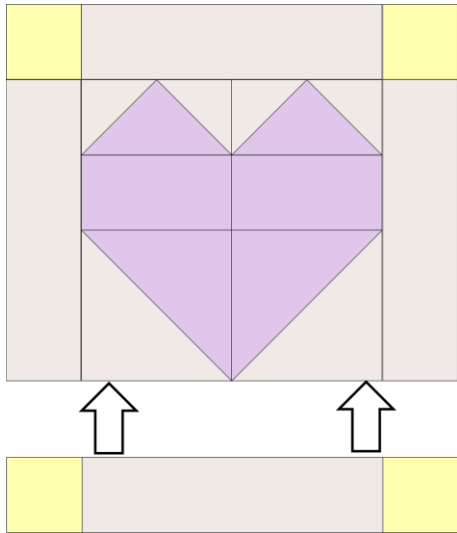


Take 2 blocks and
add a sashing/
cornerstone strip to
the right side.

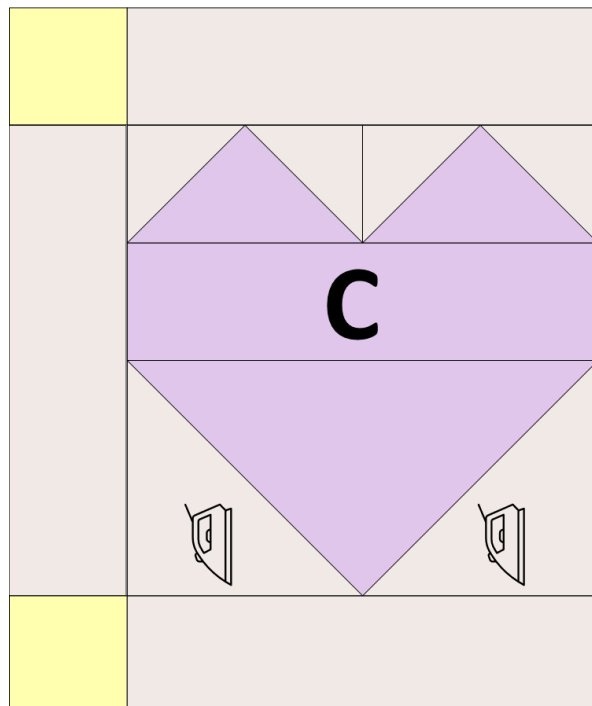
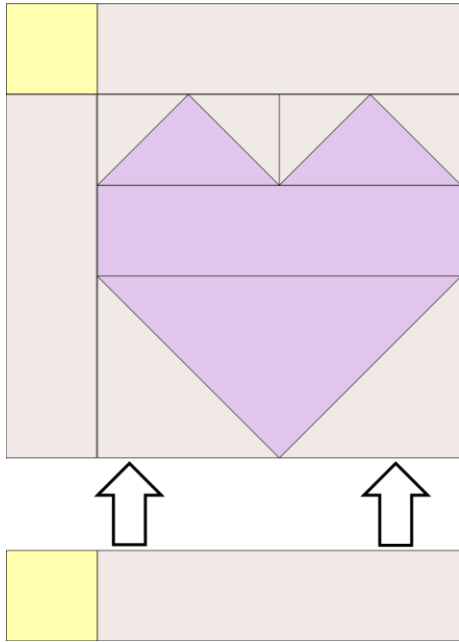


Label 1 **B** and set
aside.

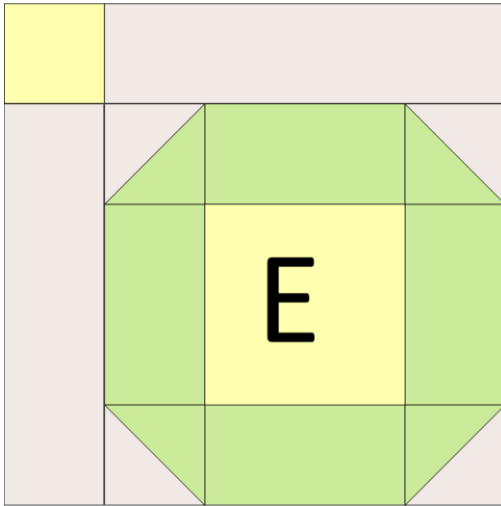
Take the other block and add the
sashing/cornerstones strip to the bottom.
Label this block **D**



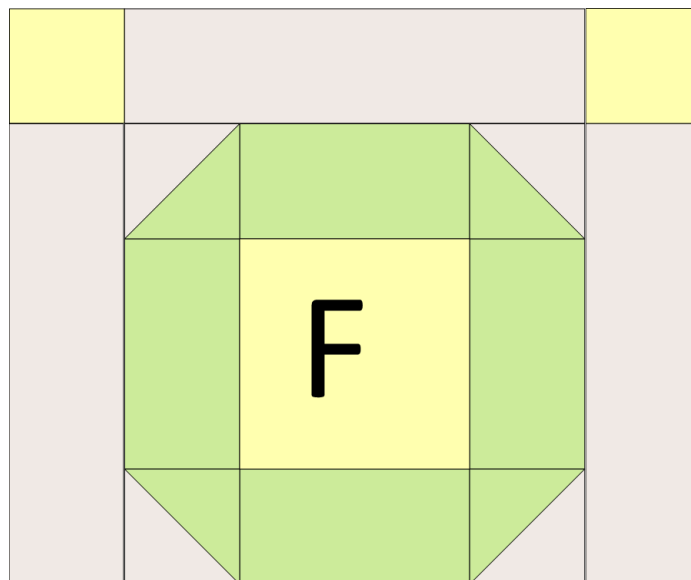
Take the remaining block and add a sashing /cornerstone strip to the bottom. Label this block **C**.



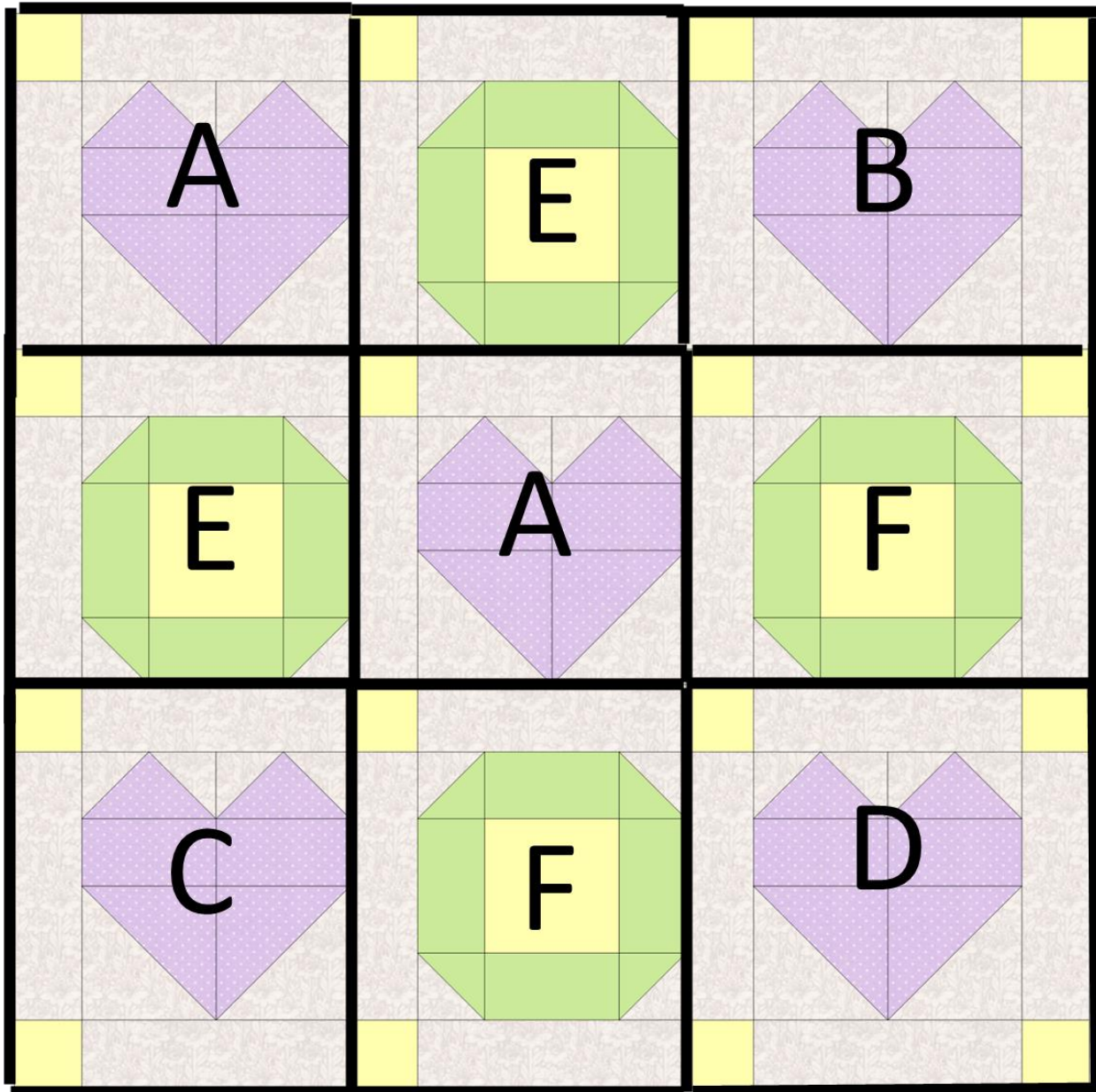
Add the sashing / cornerstones to the Hug blocks in the same manner. You will want sashing on the top and left side all 4 blocks. Press towards the sashing. Label 2 of them E.

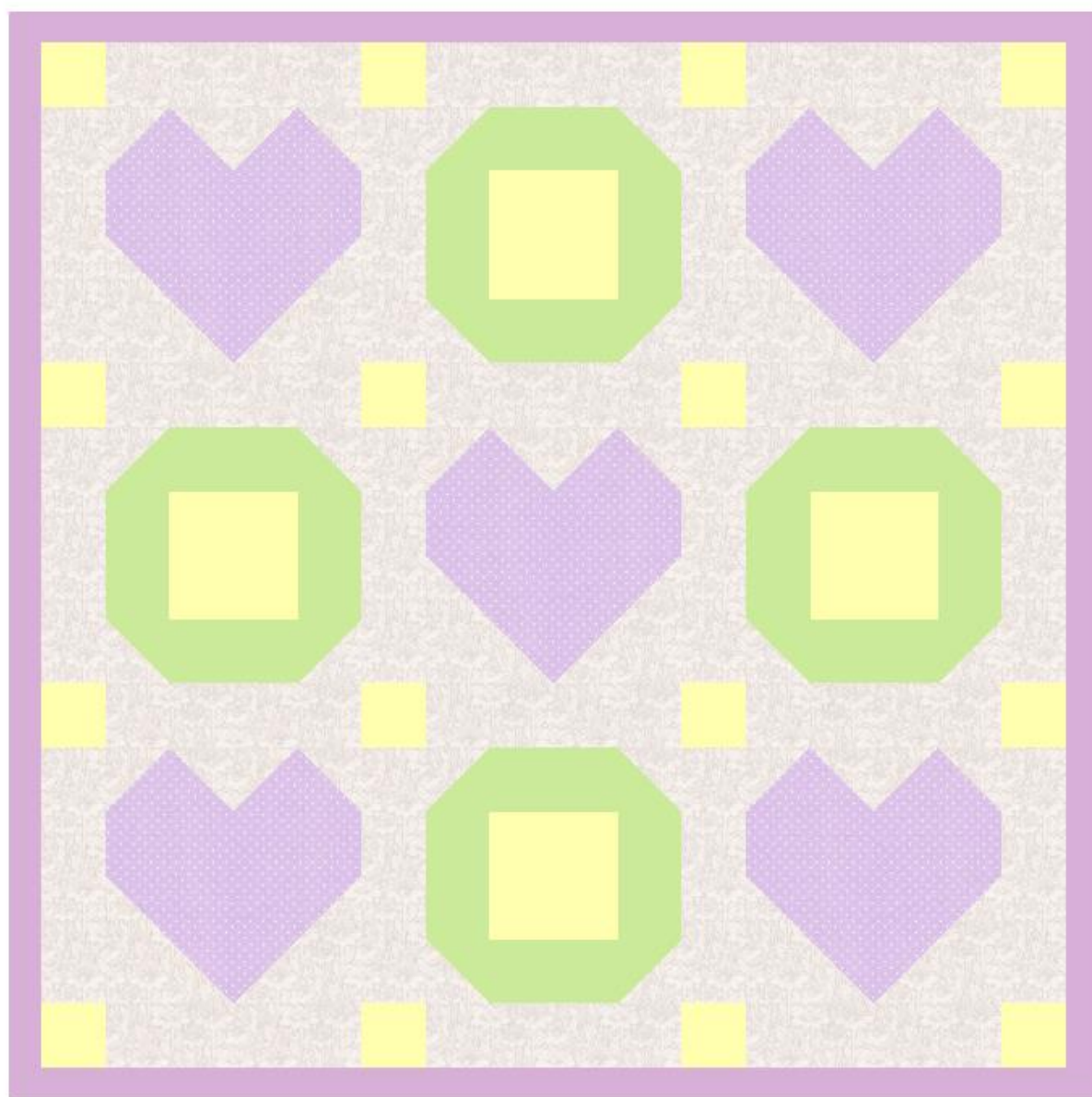


Take the remaining blocks and add another strip to the side. Press towards the sashing. Label these F.



Assemble the blocks according to the diagram. First join the blocks to make rows and then join the rows together. Notice block E in the bottom row is turned to the left 90°
